Purpose of Role:	The core purpose of the role of the Lifeguard is to be involved with the overall delivery of the Leisure Programme.

#### Key Tasks and Responsibilities

- Promote the safeguarding and welfare of all members, students and visitors
- To undertake lifeguard duties in line with the normal operating procedure and ensure high levels of supervision are maintained at all times
- To be aware of and abide by the Pool Safety Operating Procedure, which contains the Normal Operating Procedure and Emergency Action Plan
- Teach a wide variety of swimming lessons internally and externally.
- Keep accurate records of swimming lesson including registers and progress on the Swim England National Plan for Teaching Swimming.
- Undertake cleaning duties as specified in the daily cleaning rota and to a high standard, being proactive in maintaining a high level of cleanliness throughout the facility
- Undertake duties on reception as required, including taking bookings, payments, cash reconciliation and customer queries
- To be responsible for ensuring customer use of the pool's facilities is consistent with the pool's admission policy
- To be aware of all emergency and critical incident procedures, logging and reporting any incidents occurring on shift
- To supervise holiday clubs/camps and maintain a presence in the Fitness Suite as required and directed by the Management Team
- Work with the Management Team and other staff to ensure the smooth running of the facility and have a good knowledge of health and safety.
