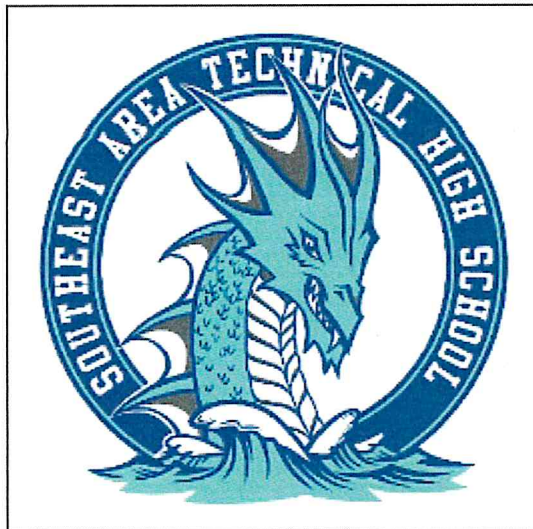

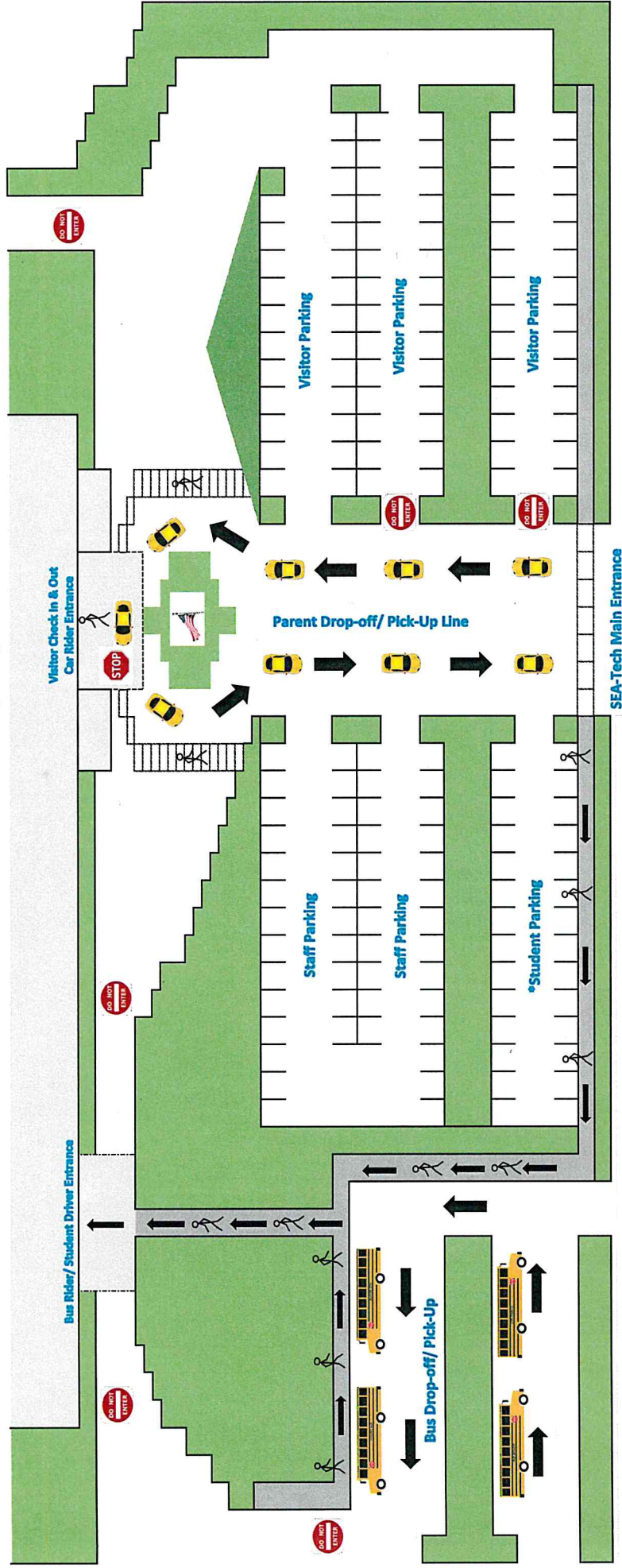

Open House Night: August 6th 4:30- 5:30

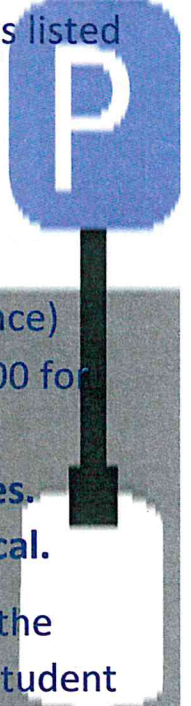
- Parking Tags will be given at time of payment.
- Parking cost is \$10.00.
- \$5.00 for additional stickers needed or for a replacement sticker.

Parking Application Procedures:

1.) Print and sign the NHCS Vehicle Parking Registration Agreement.

2.) To purchase your decal bring the following COMPLETED items on dates listed above:

- Vehicle Parking Registration Agreement signed by Parent/Guardian
- Copy of Valid Driver's License
- Copy of Current Vehicle Registration (NOT proof of insurance)
- \$10.00 for parking decal (cash, check or money order) \$5.00 for additional passes
- **Money for all school fines, Cafeteria Fees, and library fines. These must be paid prior to the purchase of a parking decal.**



REMINDERS: The school retains the authority to conduct routine patrols of the student parking lots and to inspect vehicles for parking decals. Interiors of student vehicles may be searched when a school authority has reasonable suspicion. Vehicles may be searched without student consent, without notice and without a search warrant. Students that owe fees, have attendance issues, habitual tardiness, discipline issues or leave campus without permission may have their parking privileges revoked until such issues have been resolved. Students obtaining their license after the start of school can purchase parking permits at the front desk. CFCC parking is an additional cost and is the responsibility of the student. CFCC permits must be purchased at the CFCC Business Office.
