RESERVED PARKING SPOT GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES 2019-2020

STEP 1: Purchase a Reserved Spot anytime from July 15th to August 15th. Drop off check/ cash, drawing for your space, and the application to Mrs. Mull's mailbox. Please submit a check or cash with your application. Checks payable to EMTV. **You must also purchase you parking permit at registration.**

STEP 2: Once your application and payment is received, we will confirm with you via email or phone that your design has been approved.

- You and your parents should carefully read and sign the Reserved Parking Spot Contract.
- A school appropriate design for your parking spot MUST be included with the signed contract. EMHS will keep this, so make a copy for yourself. All spaces must be personalized or marked in some manner to indicate to other students that your space is reserved. If another student parks in your parking spot during school, we will issue a warning to the student and certain discipline procedures will follow. Junior parking spaces will be designated as **JUNIOR ROW**.
- Designs must be approved prior to painting. To ensure your design is approved before the designated painting time, submit your contract and design by **8/15/19**. You will be contacted if there is a problem with your design.

STEP 3: We will select your reserved parking spot in the order we receive your application, payment and design. We will notify you which spot you have and confirm prior to painting it.

REMINDER: Parking spot selection is prioritized by the order in which you pay for your parking space.

STEP 4: Paint your parking spot, August 17th from 8 am – 1 pm and August 18th from 8 am – 3 pm.

- Personalize your parking spot by creating a design that reflects your interests, shows your school spirit, or simply an interesting or creative design (search “parking spot ideas”). Remember, all reserved parking spots must be personalized in some manner to indicate to others that it is reserved.
- Please block off your parking spot when you finish to ensure no one parks in it while it is drying. We will also block off the parking lot to ensure others do not park there.
- What you need:
 - WATER BASED INTERIOR OR EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT ONLY (no reflective paint, no fluorescent paint, and no spray paint)
 - a broom to sweep off your spot before painting
 - chalk to sketch your design before painting
 - a ruler or tape measure to mark the boundaries of your design (neat 8” unpainted border)
 - your copy of the approved design
 - paint brushes, paint rollers, paint trays, painters tape, stencils, trash bags and any other painting supplies you think you may need
 - friends and family to help you and chat with other students who are painting for help and ideas
 - something to block off your space while it is drying
 - Paint can be expensive, so here are some tips to keep the cost down:
 - Ask family, neighbors, and grandparents if they have any paint lying around that they aren’t using (you can usually get it tinted at a local home supply store).
 - Home supply stores usually have paint in the clearance section of custom colors that people have chickened out on using. These paints are deeply discounted.
 - Talk to your friends about what colors they are using, and then go into together on the paint.
 - Simplify your design: more colors = more money.

STEP 5 (at the end of the school year): Paint over your design: You have 2 options here. Please read below carefully.

- Students may keep their parking spot through the Friday of senior finals week.

- Students may pay \$25 to have EMTV paint over their spot. This \$25 must be paid by June 1, 2020.
- Students may paint over their own space by the designated day. If students are unable to paint over their parking spots, they can pay EMTV to paint over it for them. Failure to do so will result in a \$100 fine that must be cleared before the end of the year.

I hereby agree to abide by all of the following rules and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a reserved painted parking spot:

- Upon purchasing my parking spot I will only use water-based exterior latex paint.
- I understand that I must check-in at the table located in the front of the Senior/Junior Row before I begin to paint.
- I know I am not allowed spray paint, reflective paint, or fluorescent paint of any kind.
- I will only paint within the marked parking space that is drawn for me.
- I know I have to bring my own brushes and painting supplies to decorate my spot.
- I will never park in another parking space that is assigned to someone else or let anyone park in my space.
- I will only paint my approved design following all the guidelines in my parking space.
- I understand that my painted design must be completed by 4 pm on August 18th
- **If I do not abide by any of these rules, I realize my parking spot will be taken away and will be painted over, and I will not receive a refund.**
- If I park in someone else's painted parking spot, I will receive disciplinary action.
- I agree to paint over my design in black water-based exterior latex paint at the end of the school year or pay the fee. If neither are completed by June 8, 2020 I will incur a \$100 fine.
