

# BYLAWS NEWS:

## Effective Immediately for ALL Local PTAs/PTSAs

Pennsylvania PTA bylaws were recently amended by the delegates at convention on October 20, 2017. As such, it is imperative that all local units take immediate action to incorporate the following amended section into their bylaws. No other action is required.

*The adoption of an amendment to any provision of the National PTA and the Pennsylvania PTA bylaws shall serve automatically and without the requirement of further action by this association to amend their corresponding bylaws. Local/council PTAs/PTSAs shall promptly incorporate such amendments in their respective bylaws. Each local/council PTA/PTSA shall include in its bylaws provisions corresponding to the provisions of National PTA and Pennsylvania PTA bylaws identified by the # symbol.*

#### **# ARTICLE XIV: PENNSYLVANIA PTA CONVENTION**

*(verbiage changes to conform to the Pennsylvania PTA bylaws as amended October 20, 2017)*

**Section 1.** This PTA/PTSA shall be entitled to be represented at the state convention of the Pennsylvania PTA by the president (or alternate) and one (1) accredited (or alternate) delegate for every ten (10) members as shown on the record of the state treasury fourteen (14) days prior to the state convention.
