Episcopal Day School is located in beautiful downtown Pensacola, Florida. EDS serves approximately 400 students in grades PK2-8 and is the leading independent school in Northwest Florida. EDS accepts students of average and above average academic ability and offers a full range of athletic and artistic opportunities for students. Middle School PE is offered five days a week as a core course.

The position teaches two forty-five minute sections of sixth, seventh grade and eighth grade daily. Weekly faculty meetings occur on Wednesdays, which are early release days for that purpose. There is one overnight trip per year that the teacher attends with students.

Applicants should possess a Bachelor's degree in Secondary Education Physical Education or a related field. Experience teaching Middle Grade students is preferred. A strong candidate will be engaging, will have mastered creative and diverse methods of teaching, learning, and assessment, will demonstrate a knowledge of current pedagogy for second language acquisition, and will be familiar with the use of technology in the instructional setting.
