BOARD BY-LAWS Subject: Title IX -Equal Employment Opportunity: Legal Notice

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 declares, in part that:

No person in the United States shall on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.

The Onteora Central School District does not discriminate on the basis of sex in the educational programs or activities which it operates, and it is required by Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972 not to discriminate in such a manner. This policy of non-discrimination includes the following areas: recruitment and appointment of employees; employment pay and benefits; counseling services for students; access by students to educational programs, course offerings and student activities. The District official responsible for the coordination of activities relating to compliance with Title IX is the Superintendent of Schools. This official will provide information including complaint procedures to any student or employee who feels that their rights under Title IX may have been violated by the District or its officials.
