- (2) <u>Bond Refinancing</u>: RESOLVED. That the Board of School Directors of Mt. Lebanon School District authorizes the School District's Financial Advisor and Bond Counsel to take all steps necessary and desirable to prepare, advertise and market an issue of the School District's General Obligation Bonds, Series of 2017 in an aggregate principal amount of approximately \$59,000,000 to advance refund \$56,340,000 in principal amount of the School District's General Obligation Bonds, Series A of 2009 to achieve a debt service savings over the life of the issue, and to fund certain capital projects of the School District, and to obtain a current rating with respect to the School District's bonds.
