A. Financial Items

- 1. <u>Treasurer's Report</u> The treasurer's report reflects cash transactions for the month of September. The list is typical for this time of year and the Superintendent recommends it for approval.
- 2. <u>Monthly List of Bills</u> The monthly list of bills reflects checks authorized to be drawn between September 17 and 30. The Superintendent recommends approval of the list.
- 3. <u>List of Tax Refunds</u> The list of tax refunds totals \$58,221.70 for 33 refunds. Three are large refunds to 318 Washington Rd, Atlas Land and Building Corp. The list has been reviewed by the Solicitor's office and recommends its approval. The Superintendent recommends approval of the list.
- 4. <u>Ratification of June 30, 2015, List of Budgetary Transfers</u> Each year, the Board is asked to approve the list of budgetary transfers to balance the prior year budget prior to the final audit. The Board approves the list at the June meeting and ratifies it in October once all the journal entries are complete. The list this year totals \$1,320,490 compared to last year's list of \$1,346,295. The Superintendent recommends ratification of this list.
- 5. <u>List of Unusable Equipment</u> The list of unusable equipment includes a combination safe and a gas generator no longer usable for school purposes. The Superintendent recommends approval of the list for sale.
- 6. <u>2005 General Obligation Bond Refinancing</u> The Board will be reviewing the structure of a possible refinancing of the 2005 General Obligation Bonds at the October 19, 2015 Board meeting. Tim Frenz will be at the meeting to give updated information to gain direction on the structure of the refinancing.

- 2. <u>Skilled Nursing Services Provided by the Continuum Pediatric Nursing Services</u> This is an agreement with Continuum Pediatric Nursing Services for the 2015-2016 school year to provide skilled nursing services for a special needs student, including providing services on the bus. The cost of the service is \$40 per hour and will not exceed \$60,000 for the school year. The Superintendent recommends approval of this agreement.
- 3. <u>Agreement with Pittsburgh-Mt. Oliver Intermediate Unit</u> This is an agreement with the Pittsburgh-Mt. Oliver Intermediate Unit to provide remedial reading services to a student at St. John Bosco Academy School in the Title I Reading Program. The cost of this agreement will not exceed \$2,730.77.
- 4. <u>Submission of Professional Education Component</u> As presented in September, the Board is asked to approve for submission the Pennsylvania Department of Education review of the Professional Education Component. The Superintendent recommends approval of this submission.

- 5. <u>Student Trip</u> The Academic Games Team is requesting approval to attend the Annual Conference in Atlanta, Georgia from April 22-26, 2016, if they qualify. The students will miss two days of school and four teachers will attend with the 25 students. The District pays a large portion of their trip. This is an annual trip and is recommended for approval by the Superintendent.
- 6. <u>Change Orders for High School Renovation Project</u> The list of change orders for October totals \$3,971 from the Capital Budget for the following contractors:
 - a. GC-119-294 to Nello for \$3,971 for site modifications. The Superintendent recommends approval of these changes.
