

## **STUDENT Wi-Fi ACCESS**

Beginning in January CHS will begin a controlled rollout of access to our Wi-Fi network for students. Priority for this access will be based on instructional applications and objectives of classroom instructors. Each month more students will have access to connect to the network. Rolling out the access in smaller clusters will allow us to monitor our infrastructure, policies and best practice. Ultimately, the goal is to provide all students access by the end of the school year.

Access to the Internet through the Centerville wireless network is filtered just like any other school owned computer. Student use of the network is limited to instructional and academically focused activity led by the instructor. Instructors have control of when such personal mobile devices can and cannot be used for instruction. Students are still accountable for their activity and must comply with the Acceptable Use Agreement that they sign each year. Students who have not signed an Acceptable Use Agreement will not have access to the Centerville wireless network from their own device or a school owned device.

Students that utilize the Centerville network with their own mobile device are solely responsible for the device's care and safety. When not in use for instructional projects and activities we recommend students lock the device in their locker. Centerville IT staff are not responsible for troubleshooting problems with students' personal devices.

We expect this to be a valuable resource for teaching and learning in the classroom.
