Upper Practice Field Update

Tonight I would like to give you an update on the progress of the Upper Practice Field. As you know, the board approved the installation of an artificial turf, regulation size field of the Upper Practice Field. As of today, the excavation work is about 90 % complete. The engineering site work has been laid out. The contractor is beginning to grade the site. There were several trees around the field that needed to be removed in order to fit the field on the space and that work has been completed. We will replace those trees with trees approved by the municipality after the project is complete. The fencing that existed around the field has been removed in several areas and will be replaced at the conclusion of the project. After the excess soil is removed, the contractor will begin installing the retaining wall and the drainage system. We anticipate the project will be completed by the end of November.
