How can I schedule an appointment with an academic advisor at Wright State University?

You can schedule an appointment by calling the University College Academic Advising unit at 937-775-5750. All CCP students taking classes on campus (or online) must meet with an advisor at least once each semester. Students cannot register for classes until they meet with an advisor. Every CCP student is assigned to an academic advisor.

How will my academic advisor contact me?

Your academic advisor will contact you through your assigned Wright State email address. If you do not have your email address information (including password), please contact the Wright State Computing and Telecommunication Services at 937-775-4827 for help.

What happens if I drop a class or withdraw from all classes after the 100% tuition refund date?

You may be responsible for repayment of the tuition.

How will CCP courses impact my high school and college transcripts/GPAs?

- Grades earned through College Credit Plus will become part of your high school transcript and college transcripts, affecting their respective grade point averages (GPAs).
- A permanent college transcript is initiated with your College Credit plus participation and your grades follow you for life.
- Low grades may negatively impact potential college admissions and future financial aid opportunities.
- CCP students that maintain below a 2.0 cumulative GPA at Wright State can be dismissed from the College Credit Plus program.**
