TWELTH GRADE VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

The Ohio Department of Health has revised the School Immunization Requirements effective December 3, 2015. All students entering 12th grade are required to be vaccinated against meningococcal disease.

Two doses of meningococcal vaccine must be administered prior to entry into the 12th grade. The second dose must be administered on or after the 16th birthday with at least eight weeks between the first and second dose. If the first dose of meningococcal is administered after the 16th birthday a second dose is not required.

STUDENTS WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM SCHOOL IF VERIFICATION OF THE REQUIRED MENINGOCOCCAL VACCINE IS NOT RECEIVED PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF THEIR SENIOR SCHOOL YEAR.
