Words to Live by

This past Saturday, I was honored to officiate at the wedding of a young couple who confidently, happily and excitedly stated their wedding vows before all of us. They are words to live by. Last Thursday at daily Mass, I mentioned that the saint remembered at that Mass was St. Benedict who asked the Benedictine community to live by the words, "Ora et Labora," - "Prayer and Work." I began to think that at all the stages of our lives, we need to redefine the words which give our lives meaning, purpose, and direction. I asked the gathered community at daily Mass to think about those personal words of guidance and direction and to share them with me and hopefully with us. I mentioned that I would do the same.

I asked all of us to have a limit on the number of words. St. Benedict limited his thought to three words. The following are mine:
