



Rowland Hall: Beginning School Lunch & Playground Monitor

School Overview

Rowland Hall is an independent school serving over 930 students from 3 PreK through twelfth grade on two campuses in Salt Lake City. Founded as an Episcopal school in 1867, Rowland Hall has been an independent institution since 1933. Rowland Hall's mission is "to inspire students to lead ethical and productive lives through a college preparatory program that promotes the pursuit of academic and personal excellence." The school offers a progressive education that includes a rigorous academic program, excellence in the arts, competitive athletic programs, and a nurturing and inclusive community. Lunchroom Monitor Job Summary: Supervise children in the lunchroom, on the playground, and in the classroom, ensuring their safety and promoting good behavior.

Hours: Monday- Friday 11:15 am- 12:45 pm, with free lunch provided at 12:45 pm. Lunch must be eaten after work with children.

Pay: \$15 per hour (shift is 1 ½ hrs)

- High school graduate, some college preferred
- Able to communicate clearly with children and teachers
- Childcare experience preferred

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Lunch time:

- Arrive at 11:15 to set up.
- Help set up the lunch room for the children, disinfect the tables, arrange chairs, position the supply cart.
- Greet children at the classroom and walk the children to the dining area, assist children to find their seats.
- Circulate around the children offering to open containers, interact with students, and engage them in conversation.
- There are two sessions of lunch service, wipe off tables after departing students, readying tables for next session.
- Help make lunchroom experience pleasant for students

Playground supervision:

- Safety on the playground is critical, know the playground rules and enforce them. There is a teacher on the playground to support you, if needed.
- Playground monitors need to monitor the complete playground, circulate around the area to prevent dangerous play.

Clean-up routine:

- Sweep floor, restack chairs, wipe down tables and return to the closet, replace set up cart, mop the floor.
