PLAYGROUND AIDE

DEFINITION

Under general supervision, to monitor, supervise and assist in student control outside of classrooms, and to perform related duties as required.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

- Supervise students on playground outside the classroom/during recess. **E**
- Supervise students at the lunch tables. **E**
- Encourage and remind students of appropriate behavior. **E**
- Report unsafe conditions to immediate supervisor. **E**
- Report accidents to proper authorities and complete appropriate paperwork. **E**
- May provide emergency assistance to students. **E**
- Assists students with conflict resolution if necessary. **E**
- Perform other related duties as required.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge of:

School safety rules.
Principles of First Aid.
A second language.

Ability to:

Supervise children and maintain order.
Maintain acceptable standards of behavior among students.
Establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with students and teachers.
Follow oral and written instructions.

LICENSES REQUIRED

Possess a valid California Driver's License

Experience - Prior school experience desirable but not necessary.

Education - Equivalent to completion of eighth grade or some equivalent combination of education and similar experience.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Environment :	Mostly outside on playground.
Physical Abilities:	
Vision (which may be corrected)	To read small print and maintain records.
Hearing (which may be corrected)	To communicate with students, staff, and parents.
Speech	To communicate with students, staff, and parents.
Standing for prolonged periods of time	To supervise students on playground.
Strength	To lift, push, pull, and/or carry objects which may weigh as much as 50 lbs. on a regular basis.
