Shirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Solid colors: White, dark hunter green, yellow or navy blue ➤ Styles include: oxford cloth, polo, turtleneck, uniform shirts ➤ Long or short sleeve ➤ Spring Shadows Spirit Shirts (various colors)
Pants Shorts Jumpers Skirts Skorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Navy Blue or Khaki Shorts, Jumpers, Skorts and Skirts must reach the knees. ➤ Styles: Stretch, cotton cloth, and polyester blends
Belts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Belts must be worn with tucked in shirts (grades 2-5)
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Tennis shoes are the only acceptable shoes. ➤ Boots with rubber heels are allowed during the winter. ➤ Special footwear on PTA free dress days assigned on the yearly calendar.
Outerwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Cardigan style sweaters and school sweatshirts (no hoodies). Any style coats may be worn but not in the classrooms.
Backpacks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Any type, color, or material. No Rolling Backpacks.
Special Days	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Field Trips – Standardized dress or SSE spirit shirts and jeans as determined by administration ➤ Picture Days- Dress clothes or Standardized dress ➤ Other days as determined by the school
