School Board Statement about Superintendent Search

As we continue in the process of finding a great leader to continue the tradition of excellence at Mansfield ISD following Dr. Jim Vaszauskas' retirement, we wanted to update the public on some ways that we will be soliciting for their valuable input.

A superintendent search survey is scheduled to go out to the Mansfield ISD community on Monday, Aug. 12. The survey will be facilitated by the school district's legal representation, Leasor Crass.

There will also be public meetings in August and September. The district will communicate the exact locations and times for those meetings soon through email, social media and the district's website.

There will also be several opportunities for faculty and staff to voice their opinions. That schedule will be sent to all MISD staff members to give district personnel the chance to be heard.
