

Methods of Payment of School Fees

1. Lump Sum Payment

The full amount of the termly invoice is payable on or before the first day of each term.

For clarification the “first” day of each term is deemed to be the day that classes begin.

(Term dates are available on the School’s website)

2. Direct Debit

If you have a bank account in the United Kingdom we can collect your school fees by Direct Debit.

Three collections are made each term in equal instalments so that your account is settled before the next invoice is sent out.
