- √ learning experiences that lead to the development of advanced-level products and performances;
- √ instructional activities that enable identified students to work together as a group, to work with other students, and to work independently;
- √ in-school and, when possible, out-of school options relevant to the student’s area of strength that are available during the entire school year; and
- √ opportunities to accelerate in areas of strength.

If you choose for your child to NOT participate in the China Spring ISD Gifted and Talented Program, please check the blank to have him/her withdrawn from the program.**
