MKA Primary School Code of Attire

Pre-K children are not required to follow MKA's Code of Attire except for on concert and field trip days, when they are required to wear a white, short-sleeved pique polo shirt with navy blue MKA logo. The daily dress code for Pre-K is simple play clothing in durable fabrics.

KINDERGARTEN TO GRADE 3 DAILY DRESS CODE:

- Plain jumpers (solid navy or khaki)
- Slacks, walking shorts and skorts (solid navy, khaki, or sand)
- Collared shirts and turtlenecks (any solid color)
- White, short-sleeved pique polo shirt with navy MKA logo
 - *Required for Primary School concert dress and field trips
- MKA Rugby shirt (optional)
- Navy fleece vest with white MKA logo (optional)
- Sweater, any solid color cardigan, crew, or v-neck (optional)
- Socks or tights can be any solid color
- Closed-toe shoes

WINTER DRESS CODE:

- Same as fall and spring excluding skorts/skirts/jumpers **unless** worn with solid colored tights.

SPIRIT FRIDAYS (every Friday unless otherwise notified):

- Students may wear dress code bottoms or jeans.
- Students may wear any shirt with MKA logo (MKA logo must be visible).
- No non-MKA sweatshirts

DRESS DOWN DAYS (a special privilege granted to students on occasion):

- Students may wear collared shirts or T-shirts along with shorts, skirts, skorts, dresses, jeans, slacks, or sweatpants.

WINTER AND SPRING CONCERT DRESS CODE:

White, short-sleeved pique polo shirt with navy MKA logo (*see Lands' End order form*)

- Khaki pants or skirts
- Sneakers

FIELD TRIP DRESS CODE:

- White, short-sleeved pique polo shirt with navy MKA logo (*see Lands' End order form*)

GENERAL RESTRICTIONS AND DETAILS:

- Shorts worn under a skirt or jumper should not be visible.
- Pants, walking shorts, skirts, and tights must be plain and have no patterns. Pants may have an elastic waist but should not have elastic at the ankles.
- No fluorescence nor large logos on any top or bottoms.
- No open-toe shoes, sandals, flip-flops, or clogs.
- No dangling earrings or head scarves (except for religious reasons).
- No denim, stretch, or sweatshirt material for any item of clothing.
- Walking shorts must be tailored to the knee.
- Shirts may be of plain woven fabric or flat knit and must have a collar or turtleneck. No gauze, velour, T-shirts, etc.
- Wherever solid colors are required, there should be no trim, decoration, stripes, large non-MKA logos, piping, or other patterns on clothing.
- When weather conditions mandate outdoor footwear, indoor shoes must be brought to school, changed into upon arrival, and worn during the day.

GYM ATTIRE

- All children are required to have sneakers in school for gym class all year long. Rubber-soled shoes or rubber boots are not permitted in gym class.
