More than 4000 mts above sea level we will enjoy the warm sunshine next to this natural monument with a nice breakfast for the morning chill. We will walk through the place and will be able to learn about their formation, operation and about the community that cares to hold the place. Our next stop will be at Quebrada de Guatin, where we will do a trekking through the canyon until reach Puritama Hotsprings. More than five pools of hot water in the middle of the desert will be waiting for us to relax, take a breathe and enjoy the surroundings. We will have a box lunch in the area. Returning to San Pedro we will have a free time at our house and then will have dinner, a delicious BBQ, with stories of the area and some surprises
