UNIFORM VENDORS

Other Purchasing Options

- General uniform items such as shirts, khakis, ties, sweaters, belts, shoes, shorts, etc. may be purchased from any store and are not required to be purchased through Schoolbelles or Lands' End
- Sacred Heart patches and red ties can also be purchased in the Finance Office during school business hours
- The 8th Grade Hardey tie can also be purchased in the Finance Office after they have been distributed to students

This store is open approximately 2-3 times per year during athletic seasons, typically once in the fall (Back to School) and once in the spring for a limited window (1-2 weeks). An email is sent to families prior to the store opening.

SCHOOL UNIFORM REGULATIONS

All articles of clothing should be clearly marked in permanent ink with the student's name. The Schools cannot be responsible for unmarked clothing.

- Uniforms must be clean and without rips, tears, or holes.
- Clothes must fit properly. This means no oversized or tight clothing, and modest skirt and short lengths. Skirts and shorts must be no more than two (2) inches above the knee.
- The decision of the administration as to appropriate fit is final. Parents bear the risk that ill-fitting uniforms will have to be replaced.
- All shirts and blouses are to be tucked in at all times. No cargo pants or shorts (pants or shorts with exterior pockets), no "skinny" khakis are allowed. Think "Docker style" for khaki slacks and navy walking shorts.
- The wearing of jewelry is not allowed. The only exceptions to this are religious medals, simple wristwatches, and, one pair of small, pierced, post earrings.
- Nail polish, makeup, and hair dyed an unnatural color are not allowed, including out-of-uniform days.
- Shoes should not have heels in excess of one (1) inch. Rubber soled, non-scuff shoes are requested. No shoes with built-in wheels or rollers are allowed anywhere on the school campus. High-heels and kitten-heels are not allowed. Only preschool students are allowed to wear gym shoes year-round. No lights, heels, sequins or similar embellishments are allowed.
- All students are expected to have shoes specifically for P.E. classes with their names clearly marked in permanent ink on the outside (not required for preschool). Gym shoes are to be kept at school (athletic shoes with support; no "Keds-type" sneakers or high-tops).
- Boots worn to and from school during inclement weather may not be worn during the school day.
- While the gym uniform and ¼-zip navy school sweatshirt is new for 2019-20, students may continue to wear the original gym uniform and sweatshirt. However, they will no longer be sold.

Students are expected to dress appropriately for all school events where the school uniform is not required. Events include performances by other students, concerts, plays, athletic award ceremonies, graduations, and religious ceremonies. Appropriate dress should be modest and does not include jeans, sweatpants, shorts, or tank tops.

HAIR

- Hairstyles must be neat, clean, and well-groomed and are subject to the approval of the administration.
- No extreme hairstyles are allowed.
- Facial hair is not permitted for Middle School boys.

FORMAL WINTER UNIFORM

Worn: Wednesday and Thursday; other days as instructed

Preschool (PK, JK)

- Navy polo dress with school logo
- Navy, elastic-waist pants
- Red polo shirt with school logo
- Navy cardigan sweater
- Navy, black, forest green or white leggings, tights or socks may be worn under the polo dress

Preschool students may wear navy, elastic-waist shorts from May through September and must wear gym shoes year-round.

Primary School (SK-2)

- Box-pleated tunic (“princess” style) black watch plaid jumper or black watch plaid pants
- Navy cardigan sweater, monogram optional
- Khaki “Dockers” style slacks. No cargo pants or “skinny” khakis
- White, long- or short-sleeved, cotton-blend button-down, Oxford cloth shirt with a plain front OR white, long- or short-sleeved, round-collar blouse, with or without navy piping, and a plain front
- Solid red tie (except senior kindergarten)
- Plain white ankle socks (must cover the ankle) OR opaque, non-textured tights OR knee socks in navy, forest green or black
- Dark belt without words or logos (optional for senior kindergarten) OR Sacred Heart logo belt sold in the Driehaus Center
- Shoes should be black, brown, or navy loafers, Mary Jane or tie-style shoes with solid heels. Rubber-soled, non-scuff shoes preferred. No moccasin or canvas-type shoes. No shoes with heels in excess of one (1) inch.
- Navy or black fleece pants, with or without the school logo, may be worn under uniform jumpers during cold or inclement weather. They may be worn before and after school and at recess only. No pajama flannels or any other type of sweatpants are allowed.

Lower School (3-5)

- V-neck black watch plaid jumper or black watch plaid pants
- V-neck navy pullover sweater, monogram optional
- Khaki “Dockers” style slacks. No cargo pants or “skinny” khakis
- White, long- or short-sleeved, cotton-blend button-down, Oxford cloth shirt with a plain front OR white, long- or short-sleeved, round-collar blouse, with or without navy piping, and a plain front
- Solid red tie
- Plain white ankle socks (must cover the ankle) OR opaque, non-textured tights OR knee socks in navy, forest green or black
- Dark belt without words or logos (optional for senior kindergarten) OR Sacred Heart logo belt sold in the Driehaus Center
- Shoes should be black, brown, or navy loafers, Mary Jane or tie-style shoes with solid heels. Rubber-soled, non-scuff shoes preferred. No moccasin or canvas-type shoes. No shoes with heels in excess of one (1) inch
- Navy or black fleece pants, with or without the school logo, may be worn under uniform jumpers during cold or inclement weather. They may be worn before and after school and at recess only. No pajama flannels or any other type of sweatpants are allowed

Middle School (6-8)

- Classic, full-length body and sleeve, navy blazer (non-Bolero style) with Academy/Harvey emblem (blazers with emblem sold through Schoolbellies OR emblem sold separately)
- Kick-pleat, black watch plaid skirt or skort, no more than 2 inches above the knee (no exceptions) OR black watch plaid pants
- White, long- or short-sleeved cotton-blend, button-down Oxford cloth shirt with a plain front
- Opaque, non-textured, solid tights OR knee socks in navy, forest green or black
- Khaki “Dockers” style slacks. No cargo pants or “skinny” khakis
- Solid red tie
- Dark belt without words or logos (optional for senior kindergarten) OR Sacred Heart logo belt sold in the Driehaus Center
- Shoes should be black, brown, or navy loafers, Mary Jane or tie-style shoes with solid heels. Rubber-soled, non-scuff shoes preferred. No moccasin or canvas-type shoes. No shoes with heels in excess of one (1) inch
- Navy or black fleece pants, with or without the school logo, may be worn under uniform jumpers during cold or inclement weather. They may be worn before and after school and at recess only. No pajama flannels or any other type of sweatpants are allowed

INFORMAL WINTER UNIFORM

Worn: Monday, Tuesday, and Friday; October-April

Same as Formal Winter Uniform, with the option of wearing:

- Navy school sweatshirt (*new for 2019-20*)
 - ¼-zip heavy OR
 - light navy pullover
- Navy sweater may also be worn

SUMMER UNIFORM

Worn: September, May and June (SK-8 only)

- Navy school sweatshirt (*new for 2019-20*) - ¼-zip heavy or light navy pullover.
- Navy walking shorts, not to be more than two (2) inches above the knee, with or without cuffs. No skirts or cargo shorts
- Dark belt if shorts have belt loops, without words or logos (optional in senior kindergarten) OR Sacred Heart logo belt sold in the Driehaus Center
- White, short sleeved polo shirt, without logos, worn tucked in
- Gym shoes should be plain, mostly solid-colored with no wheels, lights, heels, sequins, or similar embellishments. High-tops not permitted. Top-siders and boat shoes are permitted for Middle School students only
- White socks, which must be visible above shoes

OUT-OF-UNIFORM DAYS

Worn: First Friday of every month, excluding September, May, and June

- No t-shirts with inappropriate messages.
- No ripped or torn clothing.
- No sweatpants or shorts unless approved by Division Head.
- No clogs, backless shoes, or sandals.
- Modest dress: no shoulders, stomachs, or thighs exposed.
- Leggings must be worn with a top that reaches two (2) inches above the knees.

GYM UNIFORM

PK-Grade 4

- Regular school uniform is worn
- Shorts (any type) may be worn under jumpers for gym activities
- Gym shoes to be kept at school (athletic shoes with support; no “Keds-type” sneakers or high-tops) – *Note: not required for preschool students*

Grade 5-8 (*new gym uniform for 2019-20*)

- Light grey sport wicking t-shirt with school logo and red shorts with school logo – purchased through Schoolbelles.
- Gym shoes to be kept at school (athletic shoes with support; no “Keds-type” sneakers or high-tops).

** Navy school sweatshirt and gym uniform from the past year may be worn during the 2019-20 school year. However, these items are no longer available for purchase.*
