

VEHICLE REPLACEMENT

District owned vehicles are an expensive, but valuable resource. These vehicles, however, have an optimum life expectancy. If vehicles are kept for a time greater than this optimum, maintenance and safety costs exceed the benefits of keeping the vehicles in operation.

The Tracy Unified School District Board of Trustees want to ensure that the district continues to provide safe and cost effective vehicles for staff and students. This policy provides guidance for maintaining district vehicles.
