Here's a brief description of each committee:

**Back to School Party:** This committee organizes a 1 hour Back to School party on the first Friday of school (Aug 23).

**Welcome Wagon:** This committee helps welcome new families to Wood Oaks with a phone call or coffee early in the beginning of the year.

**Book Fair:** This is held during February conferences - eve of February 5th and all day February 6th. Committee members negotiate Book Fair contract, recruit volunteers, work with the librarian to handle publicity, oversee student previews and set up/tear down. 6-8 committee members preferred.

**Directory:** Members of the Directory Committee work mostly in September. The committee is responsible for reviewing the information each family submits as part of the on-line registration process and making sure that every family's information is included and correct.

**Social Dance:** This is a fun series of events for 6th graders only. For 4 Fridays in the Fall (10/25, 11/1, 11/22, 12/6, at 7 pm - 8.15 pm), 6th grade boys and girls come to Social Dance night to learn dance from an instructor. Your student will love these fun and social lessons, interacting with each other, through learning dances and proper dance etiquette. This

committee needs the chair to set up the details with our secured Dance instructor and volunteers to chaperone the event on these dates.

**Event Support:** Helps throughout the year at school-sponsored events, including Fall Skate (Nov 8), Spring event (date TBD), Packet Pick Up, the District 27 5k, and, elsewhere as needed. 2-4 committee members preferred.

**Teacher Appreciation:** Organize a luncheon for the teachers in August, in December and plan Teacher Appreciation Week in May - previous favorites include gelato, massages and umbrellas. 10 committee members needed.

**Graduation Party:** This committee organizes the 8th grade Graduation party on June 8th. The event is typically held at WhirlyBall. Committee is seeking a chair and 4-6 volunteers.

**Spirit wear:** This committee selects items to be sold at the beginning of the school year and then handle distribution to students by November. Sales at packet pick-up, curriculum nights and 5th grade orientation night in April are the most productive for sales. 2-3 committee members preferred.
