

SHS Choral Guild - Volunteer Interest Survey Timeline

- The Choral Guild (CG) Volunteer Interest Survey is presented to the CG Board Members at the CG February General Meeting. After the meeting, it is emailed to all SHS CG Members and posted on the SHS CG website and in the March/April Quarter Notes.
- Existing and prospective CG Board Members fill out the SHS Choral Guild Board Interest Survey which must be submitted by April 1.
- 3. Invitation to serve on the Nominating Committee is given at the February CG General Meeting to all Executive/Board parents of graduating seniors. Other Board parents interested in participating in the nominating committee should contact the CG President. The Executive Board will fill the remaining spots from those who have expressed interest in serving.
- Volunteer Interest Surveys will go to the Nominating Committee which will be chaired by the President and Vice President.
- 5. The Nominating Committee meets to slate the Board and begin actively recruiting people for all open positions. All Volunteer Interest Surveys submitted will be reviewed and discussed by the committee to form a slate. After the initial meeting, communication with the committee is done via email and telephone. An additional meeting to finalize the slate will be scheduled if deemed necessary.
- Nominating Committee Chairs will give an update on the Nominating Committee process at the March Executive Board Meeting.
- The written CG Board Slate, as approved by the Nominating Committee, will be reported on at the April General Board Meeting.
- The written CG Board Slate is presented and voted on by the CG General Membership at the CG May General Meeting.
