Lock Requirements

Students must purchase a Master Lock V610 from Sunrise on Open House night or on [FeePay](#) for \$5.00. The Master Lock V610 has a key lock on the back in case they need to be opened quickly due to an emergency. These locks will be used by your student through grade 12. Special education students may have a different lock, please coordinate this request with your special education teacher.

FLEX is a free after school program at Central and Sunrise Park Middle School. The program includes a variety of opportunities for students, including academic support, recreation time, clubs, and service opportunities. Clubs are teacher-led as well as youth-generated. The program runs Monday-Thursday after school only. Students can take the activity bus home, walk, or be picked up by a guardian. All students must be registered for the program.

Cell Phone Guidelines

The intent of these guidelines is to minimize distractions and emphasize a focus on academics during the school day.

If students choose to bring a cell phone to school our expectations are as follows:

1. Cell phones will not be used and must be put away during the academic school day from 8:15 a.m. to 3:01 p.m. Students who use their cell phones without a school staff member's permission during the school day will have their phone taken away.
2. Students who need to be in contact with their family can ask permission from a teacher to use one of our school phones. Parents are welcome to contact our main office if there is a message that needs to be relayed.
3. Students assume the risk of damage, theft or loss when choosing to bring a phone to school.
4. Students may use their cell phones appropriately before and after school. This includes:
 - a. Checking in or responding to family members
 - b. Sending and receiving appropriate communication with friends
 - c. Sharing school appropriate material with friends
5. Cell phone use of any kind is not permitted in locker rooms or bathrooms.
6. Students may not use cell phones to photograph or record students or staff at school without permission from a staff member.
7. Using social media, apps, or any other function of cell phone/device to spread rumors, bully, make fun of, exclude, or create a disruption in school or outside of school is not permitted.
8. Sharing or asking classmates for inappropriate content is not permitted.

General consequences for students using a cell phone during unapproved times (depending on how the phone is used, additional school consequences, including suspension, may apply):

1st Offense

- Phone is confiscated and held in office for the remainder of the day



2nd Offense

- Phone is confiscated and held in the office until parent/guardian picks up



3rd Offense

- Phone is confiscated and held by administration
- Cell phone plan will be created with student, parent, and administrator
