

Reservation and Payment Schedule: Reservations will be confirmed when the program deposit is submitted along with a completed Tour Application and signed Agreement and Release Form. Deposits (payable to Group Tours, Inc.) and all registration forms should be submitted to your class advisor (who will forward to our office). Travelers will be sent a Registration Confirmation along with invoices for the payments due thereafter, and have the option of receiving such by email or regular USPS mail (see Tour Application). All payments following the initial deposit will be submitted directly (and made payable) to Group Tours, Inc. (not your school or class advisor).

<u>Travel Insurance:</u> Travelers will be provided with information regarding <u>optional</u> Travel Insurance along with their Registration Confirmation. This insurance provides an array of coverage including Trip Cancellation or Interruption coverage as well as Emergency Accident, Sickness, and Medical coverage for approximately \$40.00 per student.

<u>Cancellation Policy*:</u> The program deposit is non-refundable. Participants wishing to cancel must do so in writing to by email to <u>cancel.grouptours@outlook.com</u>. Refunds will be mailed within 30-60 days of cancellation notice. The following cancellation penalties will apply for cancellations for any reason:

Cancellation Date	<u>Penalty</u>
Before December 31, 2019	\$300.00 (50% penalty)
January 1-February 10, 2020	\$450.00 (75% penalty)
February 11, 2020 or after	\$630.00 (100% penalty)

*"No shows" will not receive a refund. In the event a participant cancels, but provides his or her own replacement, a minimal name change fee will apply. The travel insurance may provide refunds of these cancellation penalties if the reason for cancellation is a 'covered reason', i.e., something out of the traveler's control such as a medical emergency, death in the family, etc.

<u>Travel Documents:</u> Two weeks prior to departure a detailed final itinerary will be made available to the school and supplied to families directly on request.
