

Student Supply List for 6th Grade 2019-2020

At all times each student must have at least the following, which should be **replenished** throughout the year as needed. All notebooks, folders, etc. need to be clearly labeled with the student's name.

- 1 3 in. Trapper Keeper style zip-up binder
- 1 set of 6 tab dividers
- 1 large pencil pouch or case (at least 8"x5")
- 3 black ballpoint pens – must not bleed through paper
- 2 red ballpoint pens- must not bleed through paper
- 12 pencils, sharpened (mechanical or wooden is acceptable)
- 2 packets of 3" x 5" index cards, ruled
- 2 packages of filler paper, college ruled
- 2 dry erase markers, thin tip
- 1 set of 8 slim markers, water based (not permanent ink)
- 1 set of 12 colored pencils
- 2 different colored highlighters
- 1 small scissors
- 1 small Elmers glue
- 1 eraser
- 1 set of small earbuds that can fit in pencil case with other supplies
- 3 large boxes of tissues (250+ count)
- 1 vinyl three hole punched folder (any color)
- 1 Refillable plastic water bottle (please no metal or glass)
- 1 3 hole punch ruler that fits in binder

iPad Information (updated 6/26)

We are excited to begin our 1:1 iPad model beginning with grade 6 students!

All students in grade 6 will be required to have an iPad. Each family is responsible for purchasing and iPad through the school which is programmed for school use and interfaces with *mySMS*. This device will be used throughout his/her time in middle school. Details from the principal will be sent including costs and payment plans.

In addition, each student must have the following supplies for individual classes. Color coding is an organizational tool for students--please buy the supplies in the appropriate colors.

Math/Science (Green)

- 1 calculator (issued by school in 5th grade)
- 1 protractor
- 1 green composition notebooks
- 1 package of graph paper

ILA (red)

- 2 red composition notebooks
- 1 Set of 3x3 Post-It notes

Social Studies/Religion (blue)

- 1 blue composition notebook

Spanish (purple)

- 1 purple composition notebook

Encore

- 1 yellow vinyl three hole punched folder
- 1 old shirt to be used as an Art smock
- 1 red sharpie (singles sold at Michaels)
- 1 package of baby wipes

The following items are NOT allowed:

- White-out or white correction tape
- Pens which bleed through the paper (since we write on both sides)
- Permanent markers
- Art supplies that are not listed
- Puddy

Calculator Information for Grades 6-8:

All students in grades 6-8 should use the TI-15 calculator they received in fifth grade. If a student is new to the school or has lost their calculator, they should bring their homeroom teacher a check for \$20, made payable to St. Mary's Catholic School, on the first day of school. The school will issue them a TI-15 calculator to keep and use for the rest of their time at St. Mary's. (Any student with a calculator other than a TI-15 will be issued one by the school, and the family will be billed \$20).
