

**SUBJECT FIELDS**

The Governing Board believes in a well-balanced, comprehensive curriculum that will provide for the intellectual, social and emotional growth of all pupils, kindergarten through grade 12. It will prepare students for admission to state colleges, universities and/or vocational training.

The board believes that the instructional program should first focus on reading, writing and mathematics skills and then on those subjects which serve as a foundation for other educational development, such as literature, social studies, science, physical education, music and art, in addition to those courses required by the state.

The superintendent or designee will ensure that the necessary instructional time, credentialed staff, facilities, supplies, textbook and the curriculum materials necessary are in place to support the implementation of the adopted course of study.

The superintendent or designee will direct the development of, and present to the board for approval, the K-12 course of study.

A listing of all courses and programs comprising the instructional program shall be available in the district office.
