Instruction BP 6162.8

RESEARCH

The Governing Board respects the value of academic research to improve educational programs and practices. Researchers must respect the privacy rights of students, including their right to refrain from participation in research projects, in accordance with law, Board policy and administrative regulations.

The Superintendent or designee may authorize research projects within the district by outside groups or persons when such research is aligned with district goals and objectives and is likely to benefit the district without disrupting the school program.
