2019 – 2020**

Bible

- 1” 3 ring binder (with 8 tabs)
- pens (color does not matter), pencils, highlighter
- Inexpensive earbuds (earphones)

History

- 1” 3 ring binder or notes can be on ipad instead
- Red Pen for all classes and a Blue or Black Pens
- 1 blank hardback journal (very durable)
- Note cards

Math

Pre-Algebra (Grade Level):

- Binder, or sturdy folder with pockets on both sides and brads in the middle
- Loose leaf paper
- Red pens & Expo markers
- Mechanical pencils preferred - #2

Math Team:

- Binder, or sturdy folder with pockets on both sides and brads in the middle
- Graph paper if you don't use Notability
- Mechanical pencils preferred - #2
- Red pens
- 3 x 5 index cards if you want to make “old fashioned” flash cards

Accelerated Alg:

- Spiral Notebook for homework
- 2 Folders with brads and/or pockets
- Pencil pouch, pencils, red pen, colored pencils, scissors, tape
- Expo Markers – plenty of these!
- 1.5 inch binder, loose-leaf paper, graph paper
- 3 Dividers (for Notes, Handouts, Functions)
- Calculator TI-30XIIS

English

- 1” Three ring binder
- notebook paper (wide ruled or college)
- Zip pouch (can get 1 for all subjects)
- 5 dividers with tabs or pockets
- Red pens/blue or black pens/mechanical lead pencils/highlighter
- Folder with brads and pockets

Science

- 1” or greater 3 Ring Binder--can be shared with another subject
- Red pens, #2 mechanical pencils with extra lead, and expo markers
- Inexpensive calculator with square root function-can be the same as your math calculator
- Clear ruler (preferably flexible to avoid breakage in book bag)

The school supplies a generic cover for all iPads. However, if you want a “stand alone” keyboard then we highly recommend a folding Bluetooth keyboard to use along with the school issued iPad and case. There are several good options on Amazon including two we tested by Pluggable: Models BT-KEY3 and BT-KEY3XL.”
