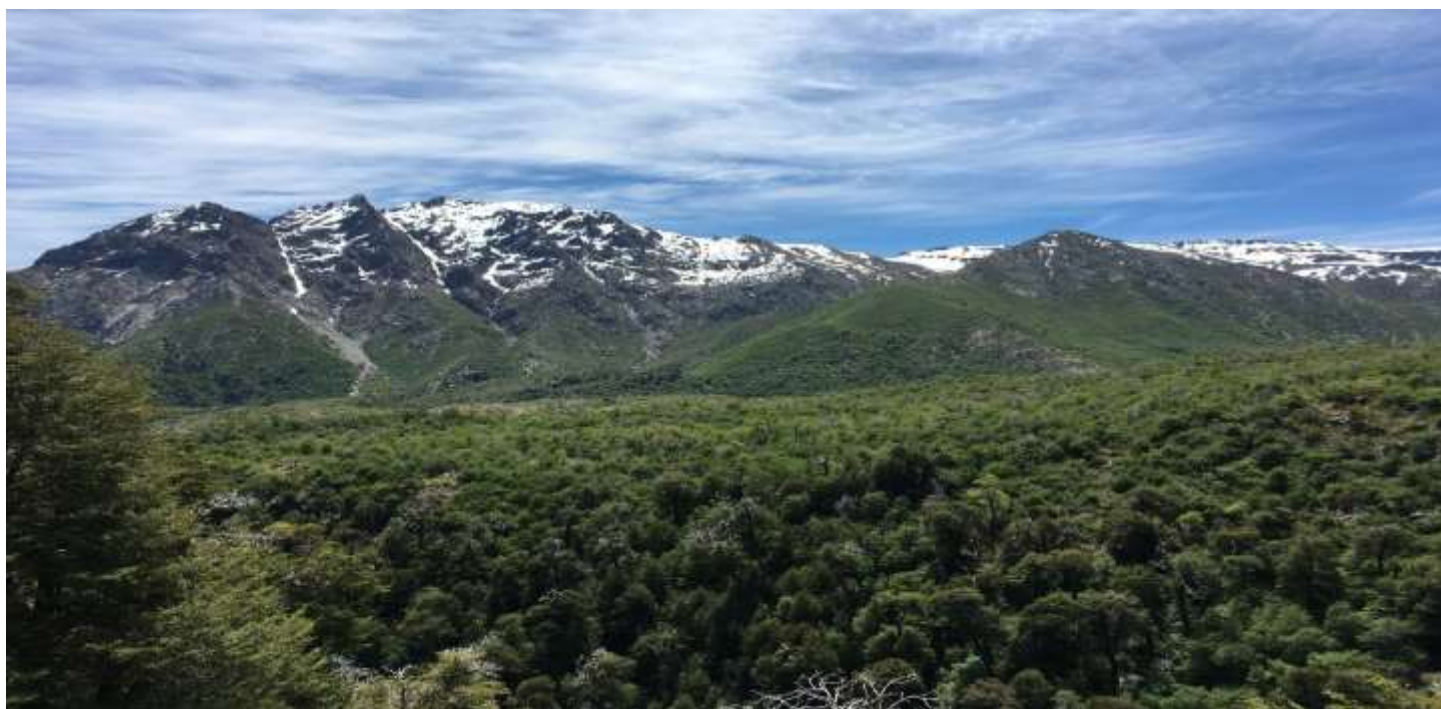

DAY 1/ SCHOOL / ALTOS DE LIRCAY NATIONAL PARK

We will meet early at school, to leave for the Maule Region, promptly to the Altos de Lircay National Reserve where we will prepare for the Interparques crossing. This destination is known as the northern limit of the Nothofagus forests, unique tres species of the South American cone. Once in the Reserve we will develop **planning workshops, tent building, backpack assembly, use of kitchenette and minimal impact to strengthen our journey.** Dinner at camp Nighttime awareness activity with the forest, prepared by our guides.



DAY 2 *ALTOS DE LIRCAY / LOS TRONCOS RIVER*

In the morning very early, after a good breakfast, we will start packing our things to take **our first goal; Los Troncos estuary camp**. Get acquainted with our horses and we will embark on a route through the Chilean Trail, where we will have the opportunity to know the Maulino forest, with its impressive coigües, oaks and lengas trees that have grown in this territory for more than 1,000 years. Lunch on the way. We will continue our route **passing by the Fraile hill and the estuaries of the Lircay river**, and we will be impressed with the geography of the place, such as the Stone of the Rabbit, which in the distance is imposed with its roquerío in the shape of this particular animal. In the afternoon we will arrive at our camp to assemble our tents and prepare a delicious dinner.



DAY 3/ *LOS TRONCOS ESTUARY / CORDON DEL GÜAMPARO*

We will get up very early, and after a refreshing breakfast we will prepare to continue our journey. Together with our horses, we will leave in the direction of the **Cordón del Güamparo, an imposing plateau with a wide view** of the Indio Valley and the Andes Mountains; which allows us to **see the Descabezado Grande Volcano and the Quizapu Volcano**. Lunch. We will go down Cerro La Chepa together until we reach its abandoned forests and finally cross the Claro River to set our camp on the banks of the Colmillo del Diablo Hill in the El Bolsón sector of the 7 Tazas National Park. Dinner at camp Night activity organized by our guides.



DAY 4/ *CORDON DEL GÜAMPARO / RADAL 7 TAZAS NATIONAL PARK*

Early we will have breakfast and we will raise our camp to mobilize to English Park and with our horses we will **cross the gentle reliefs** of the hill until we reach our final camp. Lunch. Our path will take us **along the Claro River** at all times. Once in our camp we will cook our menu and we can share about our experience lived in the high mountain range.



DAY 5/ *RADAL 7 TAZAS NATIONAL PARK /SANTIAGO*

After a quiet breakfast, we will have time to organize and rise up our camp, then have a final evaluation of the program and enjoy our last moments together in the forest. Lunch and return to Santiago
