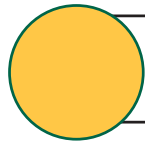
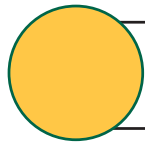

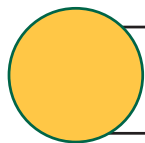
Bookmark Parent Portal Page

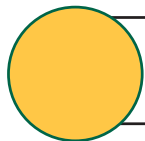
Submit Health Forms

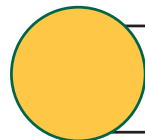
Sign Up for Bus and/or Aftercare

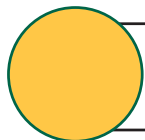
Order Books Online

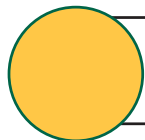
Review Summer Reading/Assignments

Visit your division's Summer Reading & Resources page online to see summer reading and course assignments. Links to division summer reading pages are available from the Parent Portal page.



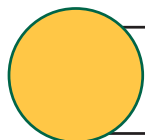
Sign Up for Calendar Alerts/RSS Feeds

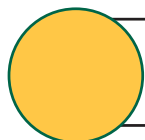
