Getting off on the right foot

- *Make sure:*
 - *Already applied to the university.*
 - *Submitted all materials to the university (transcripts etc...)*
 - *Met your counselor (Unit and College)*
 - *Taken or submitted entrance exam scores. (Passing)*
 - *Turn in a copy of your schedule to your unit counselor.*

*** If these items are not complete, then you may no longer be**

**There are over 200 college credit plus textbooks
in stock in the CHS library, located on the wall
near the central stairwell.**

You need to check the library for books first.



Please check the Library's collection of textbooks before buying one at the college bookstore!



Checking out a textbook

The Library staff does not know which textbooks are required for specific classes

Before coming in to the Library, please know the title and author, possibly edition, of the textbook you are looking for.

Where can you find this information?

Finding your textbook information (possibilities)

- On your class syllabus.
- In an email from your instructor.
- By logging into your college student information system.
- Calling the college bookstore and seeing if they can look up the information in their system.

Checking the Library for availability...

There are 3 ways to check if a book is available in the CHS Library once you know the title:

- 1. Check the online catalog on the Virtual Library page.**
- 2. Bring the title of the book into the Library and ask the Library aides for assistance.**
- 3. Check the CC+ website for a full list of titles available.**

Using the Online Catalog

Once you have the title and author you can use the library catalog to see if the book is in the collection and if it's available.

1. Go to the virtual library at: <https://lib.centerville.k12.oh.us/>
2. Change the tab to “catalog”
3. Type in the title of the textbook - select “title”

CC+ textbooks will be checked out just like a regular library book, but you will have the full semester until they are due.



Returning textbooks after a course is over

Please bring your textbooks to the library after the semester is over (even if you purchased them from the college bookstore). Do not bring them to your unit secretary. Make sure to fill out a book return form for books that you purchased (which are located at the circulation desks). Without a properly filled out book return form, you run the risk of getting charged for the book.

Grades and CC+

•If CHS has an Advanced Placement or Honors equivalent courses in a subject area, then a student would a weighted GPA utilizing the honors scale.

(English, Math, Science, Social St., Foreign L., & Fine Arts)

•However, CC+ grades earned in the college course will be the **same** grade that will be on the high school transcript.

~ *Required state guidelines*

- **So no (H) will appear if it is an honors equivalent course.**
- **The honors calculation will occur in a student's GPA but the (H scale) will not appear on the report card and the H.S. transcript.**

How many classes can students take in one year & in the program?

- Students may be enrolled in up to 30 credit hours including high school only courses:

$$30 - (\text{high school credits} \times 3) =$$

Maximum college credit hours

*The maximum number of credits allowable during the program is 120 (student's career)

Be careful there are some pitfalls to CC+

- If students fail or withdraw too late from a college course, the district will seek reimbursement for the tuition costs from the student/family.
- The grades that students earn are on the college transcript forever. (This can impact financial aide)

Athletics & CC+

- *See Mr. Dement for athletic eligibility information!!!*
- *You will need to have your professor sign a letter stating that you are eligible from one 9 weeks period to the next.*

Communicate with your Unit Counselor

- Clear communication with both the college and high school.
(Students need to turn their college schedule into their unit counselor)
- Be knowledgeable of all deadlines.
- Meet with your unit counselor about (your responsibility):
 - Courses and course changes
 - Grad requirements
 - Failures/WD
- If you are a partial or full time CC+ student, give a copy of your schedule to your counselor.
