## Steps to Apply to Dual Enrollment :

1. Apply for Admissions at San Joaquin Delta College online at [DeltaCollege.edu](http://DeltaCollege.edu)
2. Apply for 2019 -2020 CA College Promise Grant for Fall 2019 online or paper form (see your counselor or career center for this form)
3. Retrieve your SJDC student ID number and email 2 – 3 days after applying for Admissions by going to [DeltaCollege.edu](http://DeltaCollege.edu) , click on Register and follow the instructions (keep in mind that your Delta student ID will not be emailed to you)
4. Complete the College Early Start (CES) form with your high school counselor (see your counselor or career center for this form)
5. Register for course on line by accessing MyDelta student account on [DeltaCollege.edu](http://DeltaCollege.edu) (you will need 5 digit course code from DEP Coordinator)
