APPLY EARLY. COLLEGES STRONGLY RECOMMEND THAT YOU APPLY AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AND COMPLETE APPLICATIONS BEFORE NOVEMBER $\mathbf{1}^{\text{ST}}$.

ON-LINE APPLICATIONS:

- 1. COMPLETE APPLICATION
- 2. PAYWITH CREDIT/DEBIT CARD
- 3. REQUEST TRANSCRIPT

Your Counselor will then automatically receive an e-mail prompt from the Common App to upload:

- Transcript
- School Profile
- Counselor Recommendation (we require a copy of your Senior Questionnaire to write this recommendation – this can be found under the resources tab in the Class of 2020 Schoology Group)

If an essay is required or optional:

- A. Be sure that you proofread your essay for spelling/grammar errors.
- B. Have a teacher, counselor or another adult read the essay.

If a Letter of Recommendation is required:

- A. Create a cover letter requesting a Letter of Recommendation.
- B. Complete the Senior Questionnaire.
- C. Submit to your teacher as soon as possible, but NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 1st.

TO REQUEST A TRANSCRIPT:

DO NOT USE PARCHMENT FOR COMMON APPLICATIONS

- 1. Go to Athens High School website athenscounseling.weebly.com
- 2. Click the blue "Order my transcript" button on the home page.
- 3. Current Athens Student -
 - A. Click on **PARCHMENT** directions to learn how to create an account.
 - B. Once an account has been created, request which school you would like your transcript sent to.

Every school in Michigan and many of state schools are linked to **PARCHMENT**. Some out-of-state schools require a \$2.55 fee per transcript.

If the school you are applying to is not linked to **PARCHMENT**, please come to the Counseling Office.

TO REQUEST ACT SCORES/SAT SCORES:

Go to actstudent.org and/or collegeboard.org and have scores sent directly to each school you apply to.

ON-SITE COLLEGE ADMISSIONS AT ATHENS

Each year Athens invites colleges to participate in offering our students a day for on-site admissions. A representative for the college will be at Athens and meet with students individually to go over their application and to complete a brief interview. At the end of this meeting the student will be told whether they have been accepted, denied or deferred.

If a particular school is your first choice, this is a great opportunity to "sell yourself" and explain why you want to attend their school. This is also a great opportunity to discuss specific circumstances if you are concerned about your credentials.

If one of these schools is your first choice for college, you should complete your application and make an appointment for on-site admissions.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Complete a paper application (do not apply on-line).
- 2. Bring completed application (including all essays and letters of recommendation), ACT/SAT scores and the application fee check made out to the university (no cash) to the Counseling Office at least one week before the on-site date.
- 3. Make an appointment with Mrs. Sparbeck in the Counseling office.
- 4. Prepare for the interview by doing some research about the college (e.g. you should be able to explain why you would like to attend there).
- 5. Dress appropriately and arrive on time.
