STUDENT PARKING REGULATIONS

- Students must possess a valid license to purchase a parking tag.
- A per tag parking fee of \$40 per year will be assessed. No discount for multiple/replacement tags.
Tags are non transferable. This fee cannot be prorated. Please make checks payable to Athens High School.
- There is to be no sitting in or driving of the vehicle once the student arrives at school.
- Once on school property, speed should not exceed 15 MPH.
- Reckless driving of any nature (i.e., spinning tires, donuts) will result in suspension of parking privileges.
- Vehicles are not to serve as lockers for books or clothing. Students are not to be in the parking lot during the school day without permission from the administration.
- Vehicles are to be parked in accordance with pavement markings. Troy Police will issue tickets to violators.**
- Student traffic enters from John R and/or Wattles. Students are to enter their designated student parking lot in the rear of the lot. Parking anywhere else on school property will result in loss of parking privileges.
- All vehicles must be parked on the school grounds and be registered with the school, having the proper tag adhered to the front windshield on driver's side. Misuse of parking identification tags will result in loss of parking privileges.**
- All students must be licensed and covered by insurance. **The school is not responsible for the vehicle or its contents.**
- Student vehicles may be subject to search if there are reasonable grounds to believe drugs, alcohol, stolen property or other contraband might be present in the vehicle.
- Students are not permitted to leave school grounds at lunch with their cars. Students violating this rule will lose their parking privileges.**
- Parking regulations are strictly enforced. It is considered a privilege to park on school grounds. Suspension of parking privileges, issuing of parking tickets though Troy Police Department, towing of vehicles, and/or suspension from school may occur when violations of these regulations occur.
