### Community Update – August 2019

#### *About the School Building Project*

This intra-district elementary International Baccalaureate magnet school will serve students in grades PreK-5. The centrally located learning commons, equipped with flexible furnishings & adaptable technological infrastructure, allows for multiple zones of simultaneous learning. The building is designed to meet the sustainability goals established by the Educational Specifications and to achieve a gold-level LEED rating from US Green Building Council.

- The campus is being completed in preparation of the opening to students on August 29, 2019.
  - Please look for communications from the school regarding traffic patterns and drop off / pick up procedures will be.

Work anticipated for the coming weeks:

- Ledge drilling and blasting is complete.
- The new parking lot / bus loop area will be developed
- Paving for the driveway and parking lot will be completed
- Landscaping and fencing are being installed and will continue as per the approved plan.
  - Plantings will continue through the fall due to the respective planting season
- Ballfield reconstruction will be completed in the fall as part of Phase 3 of the approved plan.

The project has received its 5<sup>th</sup> reimbursement from the state, \$1,196,911, totaling \$16,935,078 to date.

A 6<sup>th</sup> reimbursement has been submitted in the amount of \$767,281, due in September.
