

PTA 2019-2020 Sixth Grade Supply List

Quantity	Items used regularly (in bold)
one	Sturdy canvas-type bag. This will be used to carry binder, pencil pouch, and devices from one classroom to another during rotations.
one	pencil pouch. Avoid plastic boxes. These break and are dropped by some regularly.
one dozen	#2 pencils - sharpened.
eight	Black dry erase markers (with first/last name on marker. Try using a label or masking tape).
one	White board eraser (an old sock will do)
3 packages	3-hole punched college ruled paper. Place one package in your binder, place one in your desk at school, and leave the rest at home until you need it.
four	Spiral notebooks (college ruled). These are used for several subjects.
one	2 inch binder with five section dividers. The dividers should be labeled and ready for the first day of school as follows: language arts, math, social studies, science, and miscellaneous. Avoid pocket dividers.
one	White Pearl or Magic Rub eraser.
four	Highlighters. Two yellow, one pink, and one blue or green.
one	Headphones/earbuds for computer use (in baggie marked with name).
two	Glue sticks.
one	Sharpened colored pencil set (8 basic colors).
	Beneficial for personal use - some are supplied to the class in limited quantities.
one	Pair of scissors.
two	Packages 3x3 sticky notes (avoid accordion styles packages).
one	12-inch ruler (centimeters and inches).
one	Calculator (larger than your palm is best) NO GRAPHING CALCULATORS!!! Calculators that perform Order of Operations are okay for practice but cannot be used on quizzes and tests. Keep it simple: add, subtract, multiply, and divide is all that is needed.
two	Pens for correcting (any of these colors: purple, blue, or red).
one	Package of page reinforcers. Those little hole-punched stickers that keep notebook pages from falling out of binders.
	Classroom donations are appreciated for these items
three	Boxes of facial tissue.
two	Packages of baby wipes (Keep in mind that upper grade classrooms do not have sinks).
two	Plain folders with pockets - Do not put student names on them.
	Optional items
two	Black Sharpie fine-point pen.
one	Thin markers.
one	pencil sharpener (hand held, with cover).

Items that will be sent back home:

Crayons (available in class). Twistables.
Light colored dry erase markers (hard to read)
Light colored and/or gel pens (greens, pinks, yellows, etc.)
Staplers or staple removers (available in the classroom)
3-hole punchers (available in the classroom)
