Reading

- Key Ideas & Details: Use key ideas and details in texts to support analysis, inferences, themes, central ideas, and summaries.

Writing

- Argument: Write arguments to support claims.
- Informative/Explanatory: Write informative/explanatory texts to examine a topic and convey ideas, concepts, and information.
- Narrative: Write stories to develop real or imagined experiences or events.
- Production and Distribution of Writing: Develop, strengthen, produce, and publish coherent, purposeful writing.
- Research to Build & Present Knowledge: Conduct short research projects.
- Range of Writing: Write routinely over extended and shorter time frames.

Speaking & Listening

- Collaboration: Engage in group discussions, building on others' ideas and expressing their own clearly.
- Comprehension: Analyze presentations in diverse formats.
- Presentation of Knowledge & Ideas: Present claims and findings in a coherent, appropriate manner, using multimedia components.

Language

- Conventions of Standard English: Demonstrate command of the conventions of standard English.
- Knowledge of Language: Use knowledge of language to express ideas precisely and concisely.
