## 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade School Supply List

The purpose of the generic school supply list below is to prepare students for typical every day classroom needs related to all 3 grade levels at Timberline Middle School. These items should be purchased before the start of school. After school begins, each teacher will review their classroom syllabus and expectations which may identify other classroom supply needs specific the course.

NOTE: Certain items such as paper, pencils and pens need to be replenished throughout the year – stocking up on these necessities might be a good idea!

### Personal School Supplies

- Backpack or book bag, heavy duty
- 1 composition notebook labeled for LA/SS
- 3 composition notebooks labelled for science
- 1 grid/graph composition notebook labeled for math
- 1 3-ring notebook with dividers OR an accordion folder
- Paper, loose-leaf college ruled
- Pencil pouch (optional)
- #2 pencils – students need to have at least 2 sharpened pencils each day, all year
- Colored pencils- et of 12 minimum
- Pencil sharpener; pocket-sized, manual
- Erasers, 2 large OR pencil toppers
- 1 set of 3X5 lined notecards
- 1 protractor
- Red pens for correcting
- Flair brand, black and blue pens
- Highlighters, 2 different colors
- Scissors, small
- Glue stick, 1
- Earbuds (headphones) for use with school-issued laptop
- TI-30X IIS 2-line scientific calculator

### Shared School Supplies

Please drop off at Back-to-School Days or give to your 1st period teacher. These items will be used collectively throughout the year

- 1 ream of white paper– for student work printed on school printers
- 1 large box of tissue
- 1 package of dry erase markers

**PE Supplies** Students in PE classes will need to purchase fitness T-shirt and shorts for \$12.00. Long sleeve options are available for students who are interested in more modest options. PE uniforms will be available at the Back-to-School Days event or in the office after school begins. Students will not need their uniform on the first day of school. Students will also need closed-toe shoes they can be active in and deodorant.
