

Chief Jimmy Womack has more than 41 years of combined service in law enforcement and public education. Chief Womack has served the Mansfield ISD since 2012 and was named Chief of Police on February 1, 2013. Prior to his promotion, Chief Womack served as Director of Transportation and Assistant Chief of Police.

Chief Womack began his service in public education in 1996 in the Arlington ISD as a classroom teacher instructing students in Criminal Justice and Law Enforcement. In 1998, he was appointed to the position of Security Specialist, followed by the position of Director of Security and Transportation.
