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Colleges

Section	Features
Colleges I'm Thinking About	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Displays a list of colleges the student is interested in, along with application deadlines, expected difficulty, and student's level of interest. * Students can add colleges to the list on this page
Colleges I'm Applying To	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Displays a list of colleges the student is applying to. * Includes the Common Application FERPA Release * Lets Students share progress of application and application status * Displays a list of teacher recommenders and the status of the recommendation letter * Student can indicate which college he or she is attending
Visit Schedule	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Displays a list of upcoming visits a student has said they'll be attending * Displays a list of the upcoming college visits that have been scheduled * If a student has signed in, they can click on a visit to indicate that they will be attending
College Match	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Use one or more of three criteria (historical application data, universal overlaps, or Active Match) from MCI to match students with colleges within a certain range of that student. Students can adjust the risk level to get safety and reach schools.
College Compare	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Compare a list of colleges using the average test scores and GPA for students that were accepted in the past from MCI * If a student has signed in, it will automatically overlay the students's scores and GPA against the averages for each college and provide a color coded comparison
College Lookup	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Look up colleges by name, Alphabet, by state or by country
College Search	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * An advanced college search that gives students the option to search based on multiple factors weighted by importance by the student. * Searches can be saved and brought up again
SuperMatch™ College Search	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * A college search that utilizes a "fussy" approach to ranking the students preferences * It provides not only a list of schools that match the students needs perfectly, but the student will also see the ones that come close * Searches cannot be saved
College Resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Displays a list of other web-based resources related to colleges and financial aid.
College Maps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Select a map from the list of all colleges with application data for your school. * Displays maps of colleges from common lists like Ivy League or Common Application

Scattergrams	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Select a scattergram from the list of all colleges with application data from MCI * If a student has signed in, it will automatically overlay the student's score and GPA onto the graph
Acceptance History	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Displays a list of all colleges that have accepted students from MCI, how many were accepted, and how many chose to enroll
Enrichment Programs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Displays a list of enrichment programs that can be filtered for topic and ordered by name, location, deadline, or Most Recent
Scholarship Match	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Displays a list of scholarships students may be qualified for based on data entered about the student. * Student can add scholarships to personal list
Scholarship List	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Displays a list of scholarships available * List can be filtered and sorted
Scholarship Applications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * List of scholarships have applied for * Student can add applications
National Scholarship Search	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Give access to the Sallie Mae national scholarship search

Search/Explore Careers & Clusters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Students can search by key word for careers or open an advanced search page * Displays an advanced search section to find careers based on categories or Holland codes. * Lists career clusters that students can explore to find careers of interest in the cluster 	Students, Parents and Counselors
Favorite Careers & Clusters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Shows a list of careers and career clusters the student has indicated interest in. * Shows Holland Codes for the career/cluster 	Students, Parents and Counselors
Personality Type	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Allows students to take the "Do What You Are" assessment. * Once finished, displays lists of careers and majors that match student's personality and interest 	Students, Parents and Counselors
Career Interest Profiler	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Aimed at older students * Assesses career interest using the Holland Interest code * Gives some career planning resources 	Students, Parents and Counselors

Career Key	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Aimed at younger students * Assesses career interest * Using Holland Interest codes, give some career planning resources 	Students, Parents and Counselors

Personality Type	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Shows results of “Do What You Are” Assessment. * Displays lists of careers and majors that match student’s personality and interest 	Students, Parents and Counselors
Learning Style	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Allows student to take an inventory to determine learning style * Report is printable 	Students, Parents and Counselors
Resume	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Student can build and edit a resume according to template * Create unlimited printable resumes 	Students, Parents and Counselors
Game Plans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Surveys students about their post secondary goals * Can be assessed by a counselor in the student folder 	Students, Parents and Counselors
Documents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Access to documents added by counselors * Documents can be for all students or an individual student 	Students, Parents and Counselors
Journal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Students can write Journal Entries * Journal entries can have documents attached * Journal entries can be shared by counselor 	Students, Parents and Counselors
Checklist	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Plan milestones created by counselors made in checklist * Student can mark items as completed 	Students, Parents and Counselors
Completed Surveys	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Displays list of surveys students has completed * Student can access results of a complete survey 	Students, Parents and Counselors
Profile	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * View and edit personal profile and parent information 	Students, Parents and Counselors
Test Scores	Students can enter and edit test scores	Students, Parents and Counselors
