

Redmond Elementary School Supply Information

Dear Redmond Elementary Families,

Again this year, we will not be asking parents and families to shop for school supplies.

We have purchased most items students need for the whole year and ask that parents write a check (or pay in cash) in August for supply fees. This will cover the cost of materials needed for the 2019-2020 school year.

We tried this plan last year and found it an economical way to ensure students had needed supplies, with the added bonus of relieving parental stress. We received positive feedback on this practice last year, and as a fellow parent, I know how stressful school shopping can be!

Supply Fees will be as follows: (Envelopes will be available in classrooms at Curriculum Night - checks payable to Redmond Elementary)

K, 1, 2, 3: \$30 per child

4, 5: \$35 per child

2/3Q, 4/5Q: \$40 per child

If you need assistance, please mark this on the fee envelope or let me or your child's teacher know.

If you would like to "pay it forward" for another family in our community who may need assistance, please do. You can mark this on your envelope as well.

Additionally, all students should have a **backpack clearly labeled with their name.**

Grade specific items to shop for this summer are as follows:

Kindergarten: Snacks to share with the class

First Grade: Sturdy pencil box, one folder with pockets, snacks to share

Second Grade: Sturdy pencil box (labeled with name), two folders with pockets

Second/Third Grade Quest: Sturdy pencil box (labeled with name)

Third Grade: Earbuds or headphones (labeled with name), Small pencil box (labeled with name), one folder with pockets

Fourth Grade: Earbuds or headphones (labeled), two zippered pencil pouches (labeled with name)

Fourth/Fifth Grade Quest: Earbuds or headphones (labeled with name), 3 ring 3" binder, plastic pencil box

Fifth Grade: Earbuds or headphones (labeled with name), enclosed pencil sharpener

We have some of these items available if your family requires assistance – please contact me at kgometz@lwsd.org or ask in the office once we open again at the end of August.
