Cell Phone Expectations



We would like our students to have the ability to relate to and communicate with people face to face, use cell phones in a respectful and responsible manner, and be able to focus without distractions in the classroom.

Students will be utilizing their TSD iPad as a learning tool throughout the day. It is their responsibility to bring this device to school each day.

Q: Can I use my cell phone before or after school?

A: Yes, students may use their phones before 8:09 a.m. and after 3:03 p.m. Students may also use their device during their assigned lunch period.

Q: If I don't have my iPad with me, can I use my cell phone instead?

A: No, it is an expectation that students have their iPad at school daily.

Q: What if I have my phone out during a non-designated time?

A:

First Offense: Teacher will ask for your phone and will keep it until the end of the hour.

Second Offense: Teacher will ask for your phone and it will be placed in the office for you to pick up at the end of the day. Parents will be notified.

Third Offense: Teacher will ask for your phone, it will be placed in the office and your parents will need to pick it up from Mr. Mueller or Mrs. Vergauwen. A plan will be developed for appropriate cell phone use.
