- Families that wish to buy books before the assigned day may **ONLY** purchase new copies. Used books may not be purchased until the assigned day and time.



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CAMPUS STORE & TEXTBOOK INFORMATION

Campus Store hours during the academic year will be Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. The Campus Store will be closed when classes are not in session.

When a student makes a purchase in the Campus Store, it is billed directly to their student account. Receipts are available. Any questions regarding Campus Store purchases can be directed to Jeff Ryan, Manager of the Campus Store at 716-332-6392.

The Campus Store orders enough books for every student. Families are welcome to explore alternative sources for their books, but should understand that only books purchased through the school store may be returned for credit. Please note: All courses require textbooks identified by a specific number called the ISBN. If you purchase a book from a vendor other than the school store and your child has a schedule change that requires different materials, book returns may only be done through the original vendor. A list of textbooks for each course will be made available on the school website in mid-August. All questions regarding student class scheduling should be directed to their respective Class Dean.

The Campus Store offers a Book Buy-Back Program at the end of the school year. Books scheduled for course use in the upcoming school year will be considered for “buy-back” if they are clear of excessive writing, highlighting and underlining. Please encourage your child to keep their books in good condition if you wish to participate in this program. The current buy-back credit is 50% of the new book selling price.
