Welcome New DIT Members:

Dr. Scott Muri, Superintendent of Schools, welcomed the District Improvement Team (DIT) to the first meeting of the 2018-19 school year. Dr. Muri provided a brief overview of the structure of the DIT's monthly meetings and welcomed all new DIT members in attendance.

Approval of Minutes:

Linda Buchman, Community Relations Officer, introduced herself and asked the committee to take a moment to review and approve the May 2018 meeting minutes. As no changes were recommended by the committee, Crystal Fain motioned to approve the minutes. Leslie Marquez second the motion for approval and the minutes were approved unanimously.

DIT Roles and Responsibilities:

Linda Buchman provided the committee with a high level overview of the DIT's role and responsibilities per the board policy. The items mentioned include the annual DIT committee election process, the committee purpose of serving as an advisory committee to Dr. Muri in relation to district level matters and the annual joint public hearing on the TAPR report in January.

District Improvement Plan Update:

Lawanda Coffee, Director of External Funding & Compliance reminded the DIT about the District Improvement Plan materials reviewed at the May meeting. This meeting would focus on the goals and updates based on ESSA. Lawanda mentioned that the District Improvement Plan would be reviewed every spring for the upcoming school year. Elliott Witney, Associate Superintendent of Academic Research & Design, introduced Luna Nguyen who provided a high level overview of the district's work related to the improvement plan.

2019-20/2020-21 Calendar Development:

Lance Stallworth, Executive Director Student Support Services, reviewed the calendar development process. Lance also explained the work the Calendar Sub-committee did over the summer to develop the 2019-20 and 2020-21 calendars. After a long discussion and review of all 8 calendar drafts, the DIT was able to pinpoint two calendars for each school year to include in the community survey. Next steps will be to draft the calendar survey and send to the DIT for review the week of September 12-13. The DIT will review the survey language and the final survey will go out to the community the week of September 17-19.

District Update:

Dr. Muri provided the DIT with a high level overview of the current state of the district. SBISD no longer has any elementary schools on the Improvement Required (IR) list. All schools are thriving academically, each using data to understand their weaknesses to improve. SBISD currently measures five different learning gaps, all five gaps have narrowed. Redesign schools are thinking differently about teaching and learning. Fifteen of our

schools will be going through the redesign process this school year. Separately, Dr. Muri updated the DIT on the 2017 Bond, passed last November. Dollars have already been put to work over the summer.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

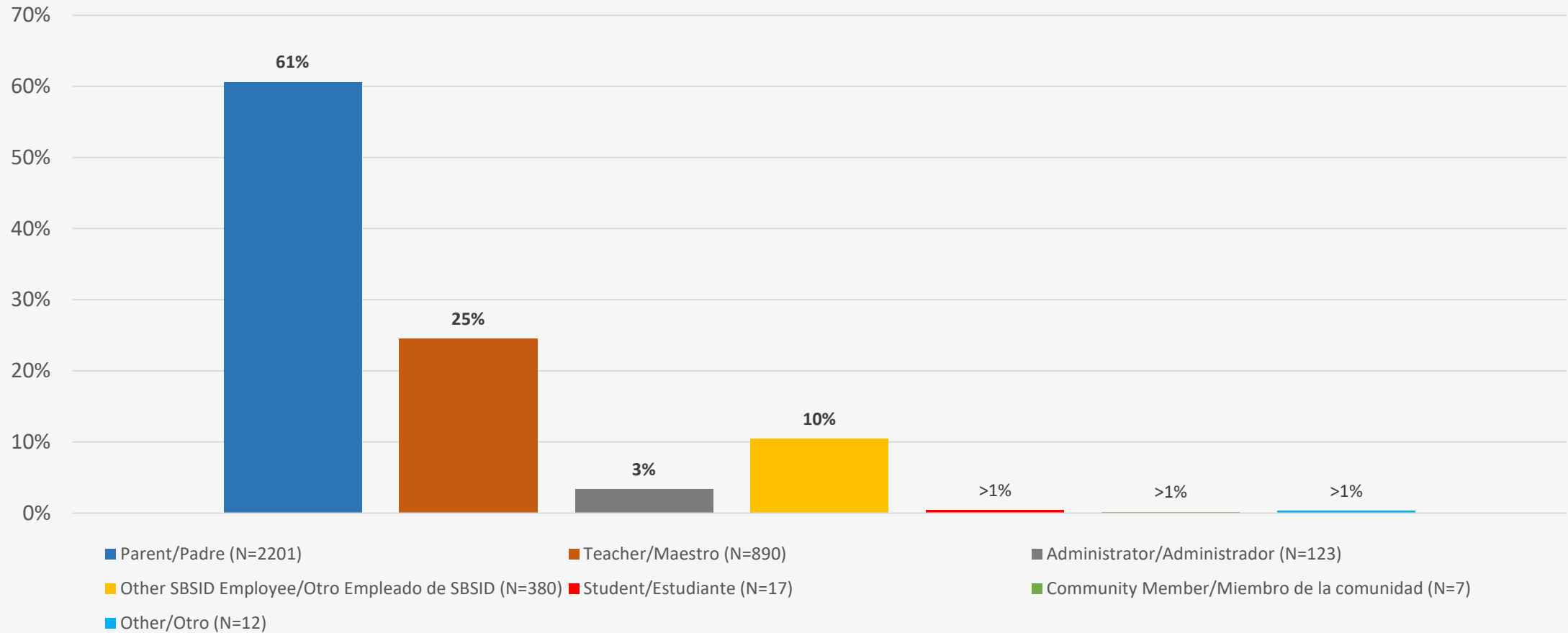

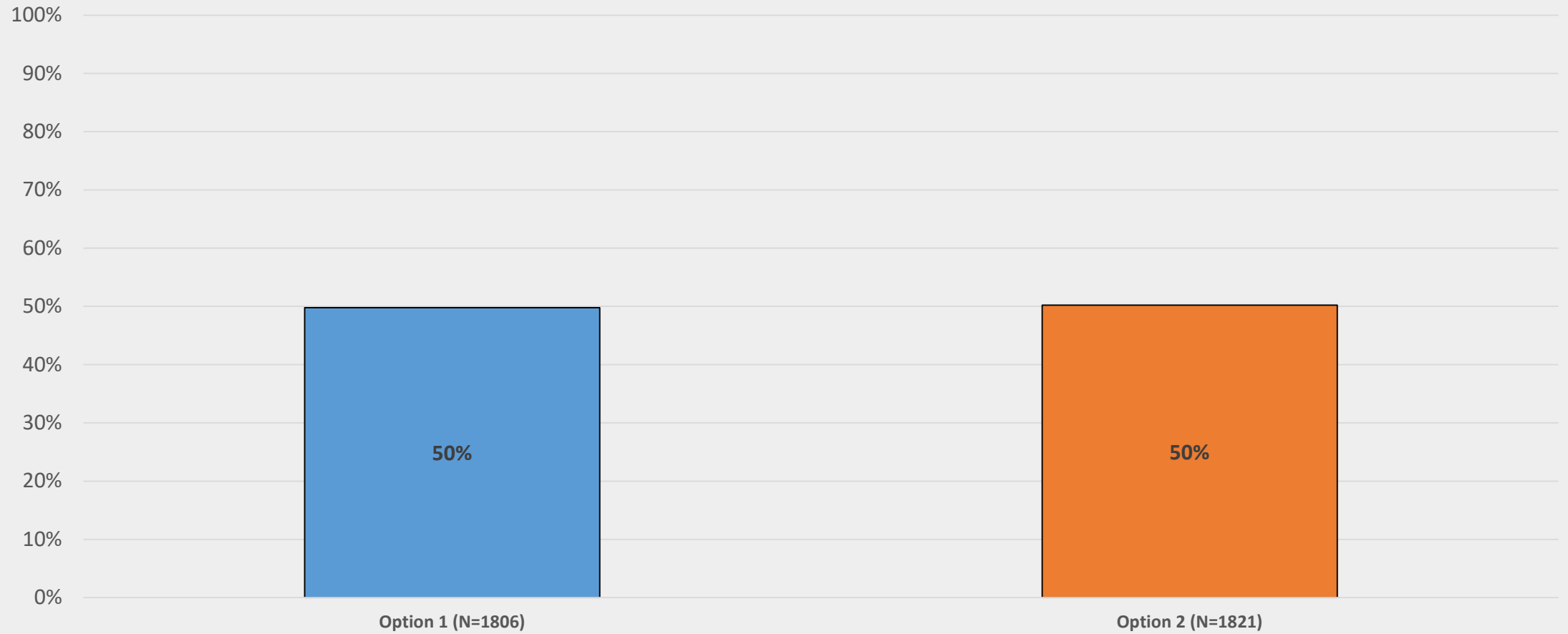

Who Responded to the SBISD School Calendar Preference Survey?

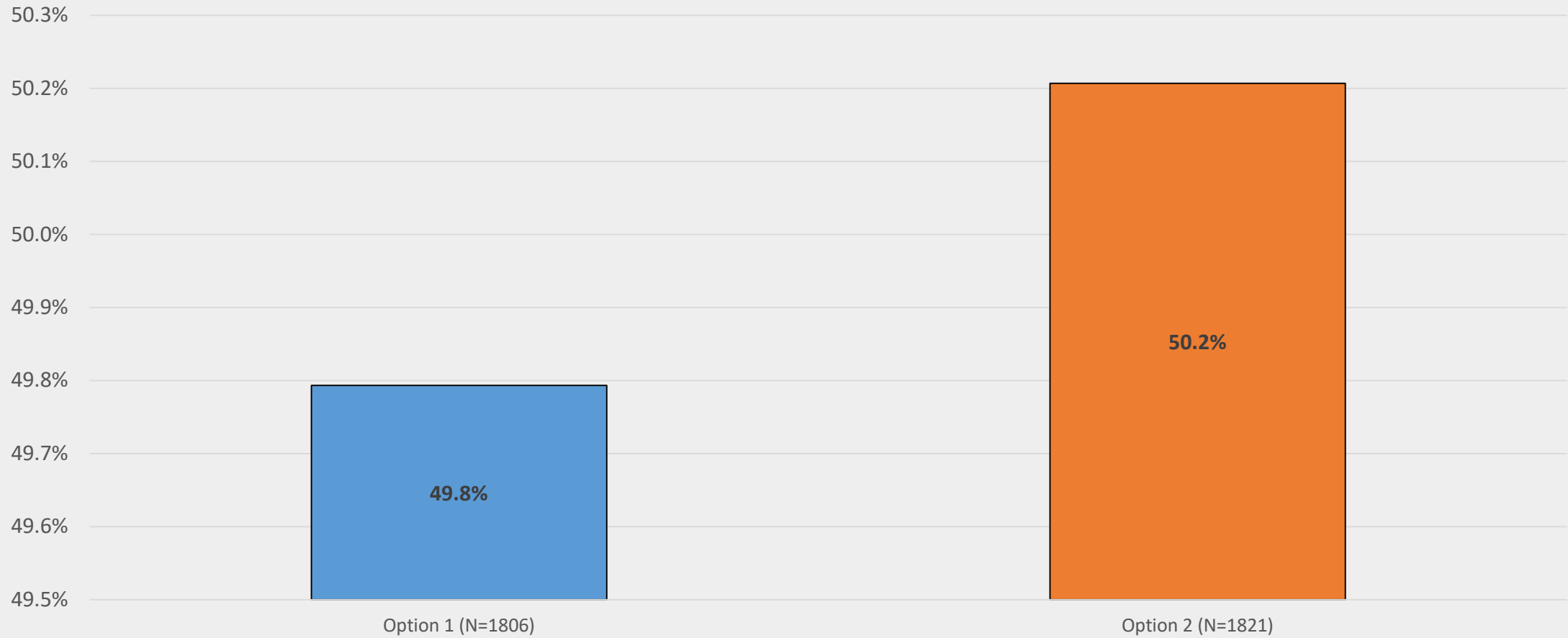

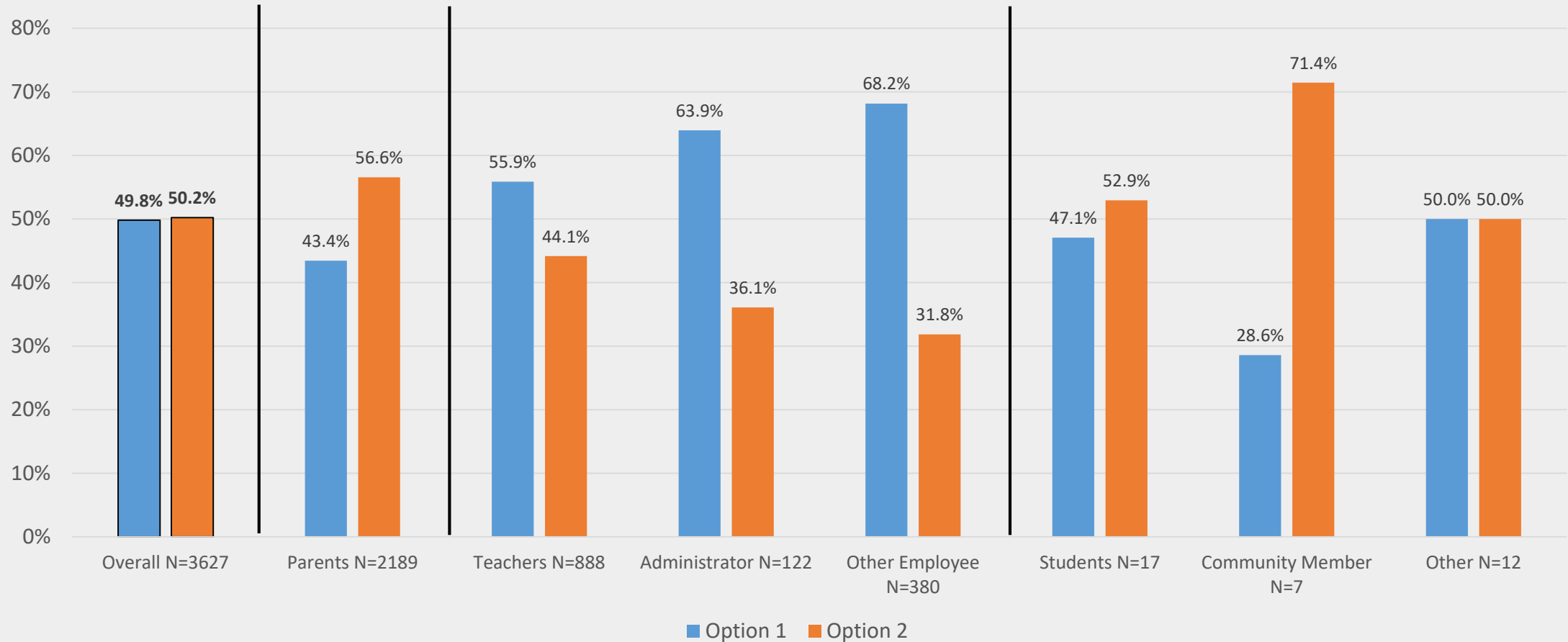

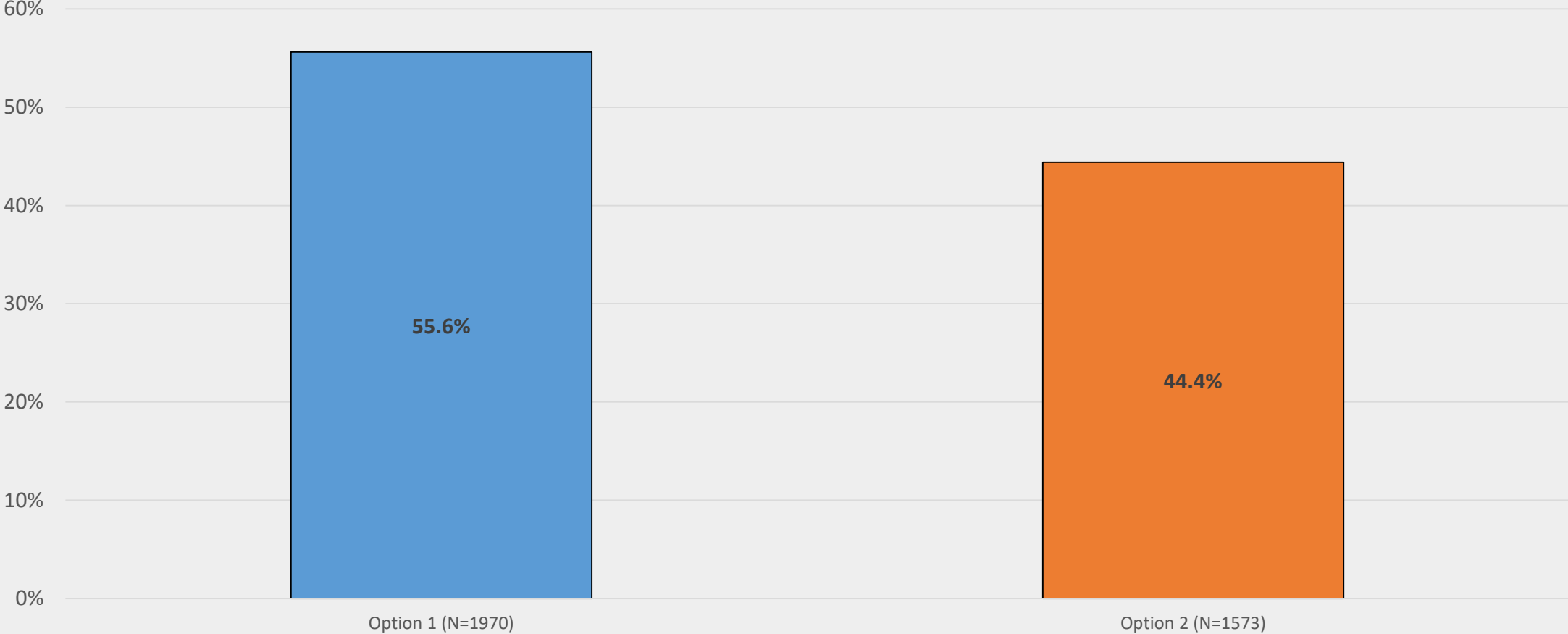

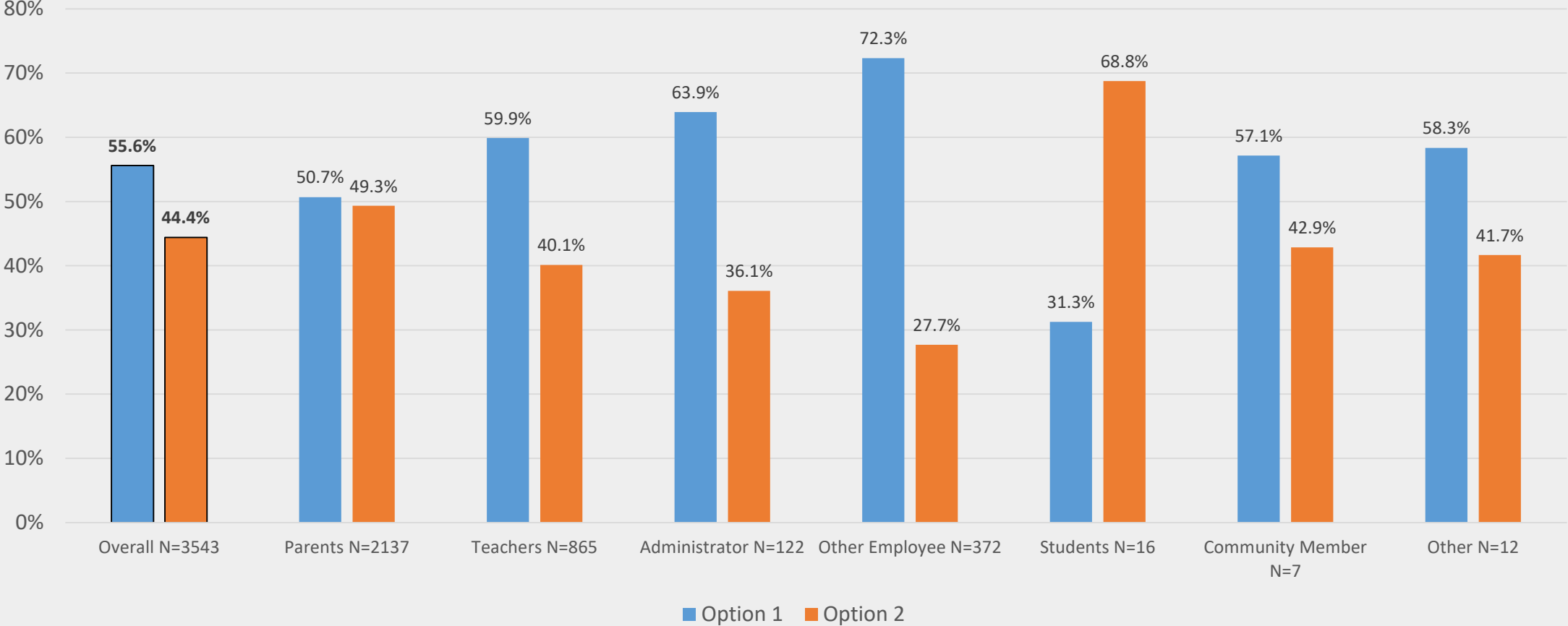
