



## VISUAL ART LEVEL 2

**CREATE: Students will organize and completing their artistic ideas.**

1. Standard 1: Individually or collaboratively formulate new creative problems based on own existing artwork
2. Standard 2: Choose from a range of materials and methods to plan works of art and design
3. Standard 3: Demonstrate skills and knowledge in a chosen art form through experimentation, practice, and persistence.
4. Standard 4: Refine original works of art based on responses from peers.

**PRESENT: Students will refine and select artistic works for presentation**

1. Analyze, select, and critique personal artwork for a portfolio presentation.
2. Evaluate, select, and apply methods to appropriately display artwork in a specific event.

**RESPOND: Students will evaluate how works of art will convey meaning to the viewer**

1. Recognize and describe personal aesthetic responses to the natural world.
2. Evaluate and identify the effectiveness of an image to influence ideas, feelings, and behaviors.

**CONNECT: Students will relate artistic work with personal meaning and research**

1. Utilize observation methods through research and experimentation to explore unfamiliar ideas through art-making.
2. Compare uses of art in a variety of social, cultural, and historical contexts by making connections to contemporary and local contexts.
