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Welcome back! We've had a GREAT start to the 2019–2020 school year! Important Reminders:

Arrival: Please do not allow car riders to get out of the car until 7:10 when our teachers report to car rider duty posts. We ask that you position your student on the passenger side of the car, so parents do not have to exit the car. Please do not pass other cars during drop off. This is to ensure the safety of our students. After 7:30 a.m., a parent must accompany his/her child to the office in order for the child to be signed in and receive a tardy slip. We LOVE our parents, but the last day to be able to walk in students will be Friday, August 9th as our goal is to get students adjusted to normal routines as quickly as possible. Due to construction and traffic in the mornings, we ask that our guests park at the baseball fields during this time.

Breakfast: Please help reinforce to all of our breakfast students the importance of going straight to the cafeteria when they arrive and straight to class after they've eaten.

Dismissal: Dismissal has really started out smoothly! However, there are a few issues that need to be addressed.

- -The students will be called to a colored square to stand and wait on you. They will not be able to enter the car until you come to a complete stop.

Positive Behavior Intervention System Because we value optimal learning, we believe in our students showing their BEST behavior daily. Important Attendance Information



We believe BEST learning occurs when our students are punctual and present the duration of a school day. We do understand that illnesses and emergencies arise, but we appreciate your mindfulness in ensuring our students are at school consistently. Because we received new mandates about attendance recently, we wanted to share this same information with you.

- According to Mississippi Law, a student shall be counted present for average daily attendance if he/she is present for 63% of the day.
- Tardies WILL BE considered when determining perfect attendance.
- Excused absences are granted after receiving the written note from parents/guardians OR medical/dental excuses. These notes MUST be received on the day of return to school if the absence is to be excused.
- After a maximum of $\underline{3}$ excused days absences per nine weeks based on parental notes, a doctor's excuse will be required for excusing an absence after the school has received the 3 parental notes.
- Excused absences by parent note are <u>NOT</u> to exceed 10 days per year.
- In grades K-6, students can miss no more than 20 days total (excused or unexcused) per year. An accumulation of more than 20 absences may be one factor in determining promotion or retention of a student.

As a school, we will be implementing an exciting, "Let's Be Here!" attendance program this year with individual student opportunities as well as whole class opportunities to shine with attendance. We can't wait to tell students more about this exciting attendance program!
