




•**Academics:** A Woman of the Word is eager, curious and recognizes that her days at the Academy are just the beginning of her lifelong journey as a learner.


•**Values:** A Woman of the Word graduate is empowered as a bold, authentic servant leader with a first instinct to serve.

- Placement in honors classes based on departmental requirements





Freshman Counseling




Academic Ineligibility


Service Learning Program

The Power of Kindness

After 35 years on the job, Floyd Martin retired this year. On his last day, the neighborhood he served held a potluck block party in his honor. But Floyd never got a chance to eat. He was too busy receiving hugs and posing for hundreds of photos. People even stood in line to thank him. But they didn't thank him for doing his job, delivering the mail. Rather, they thanked him for the rare human kindness he had given to each of them during his decades of service.

Floyd the Postman, delivered mail to the same 500 families his entire career. He also fed cats, emptied his supply of Milkbones for the dogs, carried newspapers to the door, and always offered a smile and a wave. He grieved with neighbors after a family member had passed. 
